2. Ballads, chiefly from Scottish history. 8°. Bound notebook. Undated. [With letter from Sir P.Y. Cameron to Dr Mitchell Hunter, Librarian, New College, presenting the volume to the library. 13 May 1941, loosely inserted.]
3. Lyrics Dominical, or, Songs for Sundays. 8°. Bound notebook. Undated. [Poems for each Sunday, morning and evening, from January to June.]
4. Address from Free Iron Congregation, Glasgow, to Reverend Walter Chalmers Smith, Moderator-Elect of the Free Church General Assembly. [May, 1893.] 4°. [50 leaves.] Leather binding. [Signed by members and adherents, on the occasion of Mr. Smith's election as Moderator of the Free Church, 1893. Presented to New College Library by Mr. Smith's granddaughter, 25 Sept. 1954.]
5. [Illuminated address from Edinburgh Presbytery of the United Free Church of Scotland to Rev. Dr. W.C. Smith.] Folio. Dated: Dec. 24, 1900. [2 leaves framed in leather bound case. Presented on the occasion of Dr. Smith's 50th anniversary of his ordination (Dec. 25, 1850). Illuminator: R. Fone.]
