1. Index of first lines of hymns found in one or other of the hymn books in the numbered list prefixed to this. 4°. 47/4 pp. [Edinburgh, 1912.] Reprinted 1912. First dated hymn book 1807. Brown half leather binding. Hymn books referred to come from James Thin Collection, New College Library [Edinburgh].
2. Newspaper cuttings on hymns and hymnbooks, with particular reference to the United Presbyterian Church hymn book (1876). 4°. 2, 376p. [Cuttings dated 1870-1910, pasted into a quarto exercise book. Some loose cuttings. Most cuttings are dated.]
- 3-7. Notebooks in connection with the compilation of the hymn book of the United Presbyterian Church, 1876. [Small notebooks, and sample copy of Union edition of the U.P. Hymn Book. In a box.]
8. [Notebook containing annotated interleaved copy of first lines of hymns suggested for revised U.P. Hymn Book. 8°. 18p. [printed text.] [1876?] [with 4 letters on the Hymn book, from A. Macleod, J.F. McWain, Will T. Brooke, and G.A. Crawford, to James Thin loosely inserted. In a box.]
9. EDINBURGH TOTAL ABSTINENCE SOCIETY. Temperance hymn book. [Comp. by William Munson.] 12°. viii, 192. [Edinburgh, 1807.] [Copy presented by the society to James Thin, who assisted in the hymn book's compilation. With covering letter from the secretary, 13 Dec. 1907, loosely inserted. In a box.]
10. [Hymn book of the United Presbyterian Church, 1876.] 8°. [24 leaves, 376p.] [Printed t.p. and sample page only, followed by an index of writers, and notes on individual hymns. With 2 letters from William Bonar loosely inserted. In a box.]
