## WESTMINSTER CONFESSION

[Completed Dec. 1646;  
finally approved June 1648.]

1. The Confession of Faith agreed upon by the Assembly of Divines at Westminster, with the assistance of Commissioners from the Church of Scotland - approved by the General Assembly 1647, and ratified by the Parliament of Scotland 1690. With the formula for the subscription of ruling elders. folio. 18p. [+ 14p. 16]. Remaining leaves blank. [Contains: Printed copy of the Confession of Faith; signatures to formula, 1694-1857. Leather binding. Spine title reads: Church of Scotland Library. Confession of Faith 1690, &c.]
