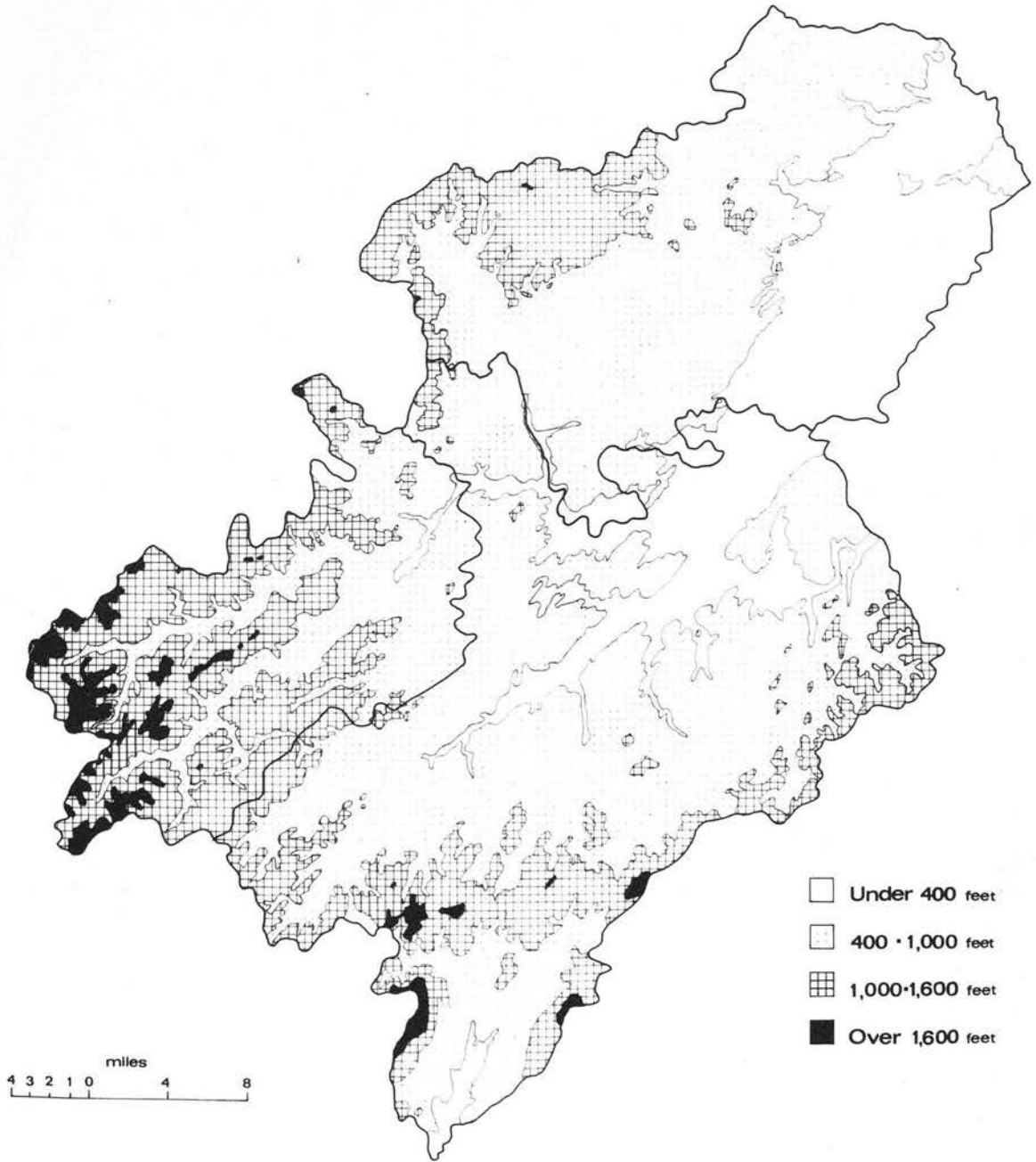

(units of over 100).

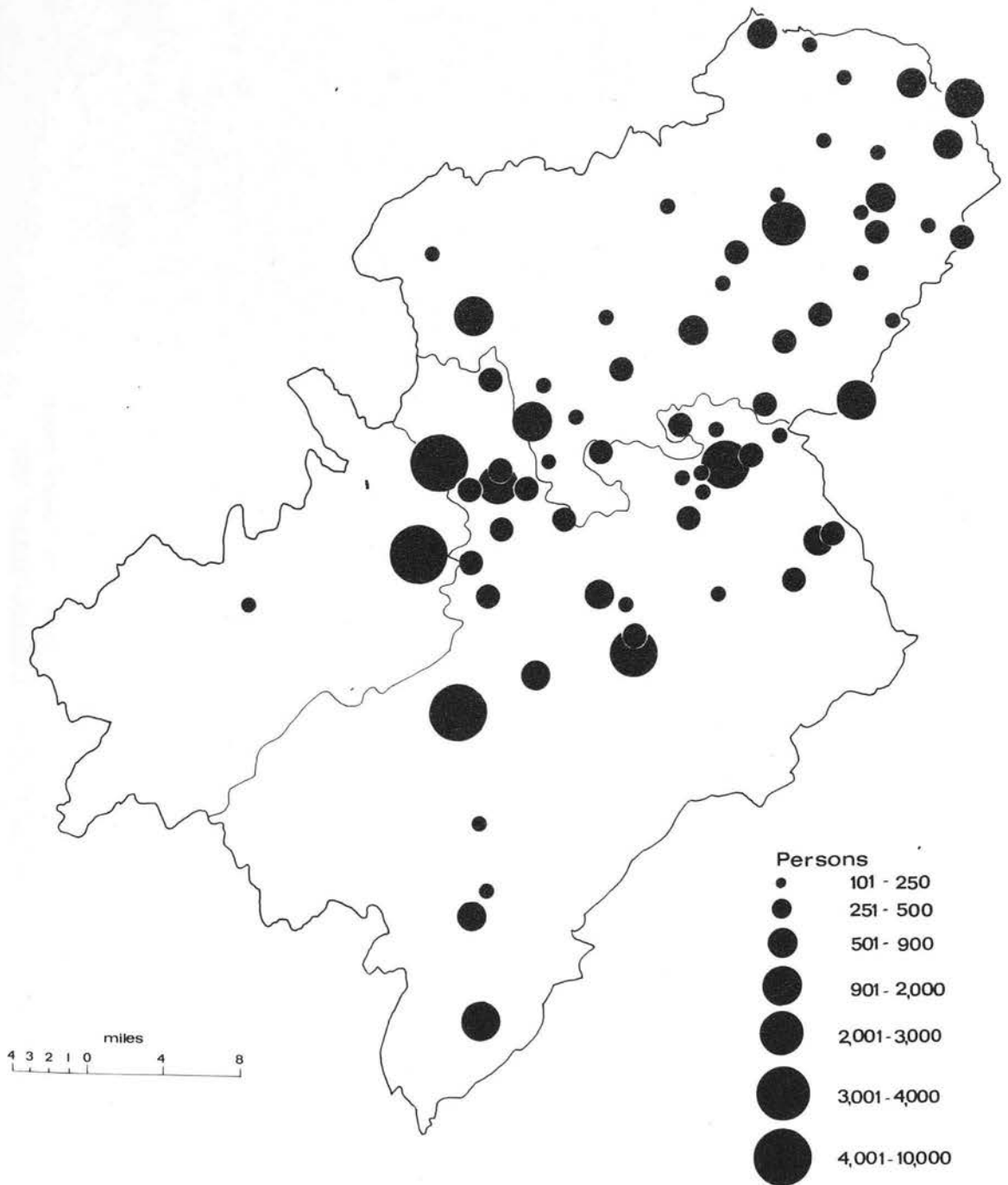

(UNITS OF UNDER 1,000).

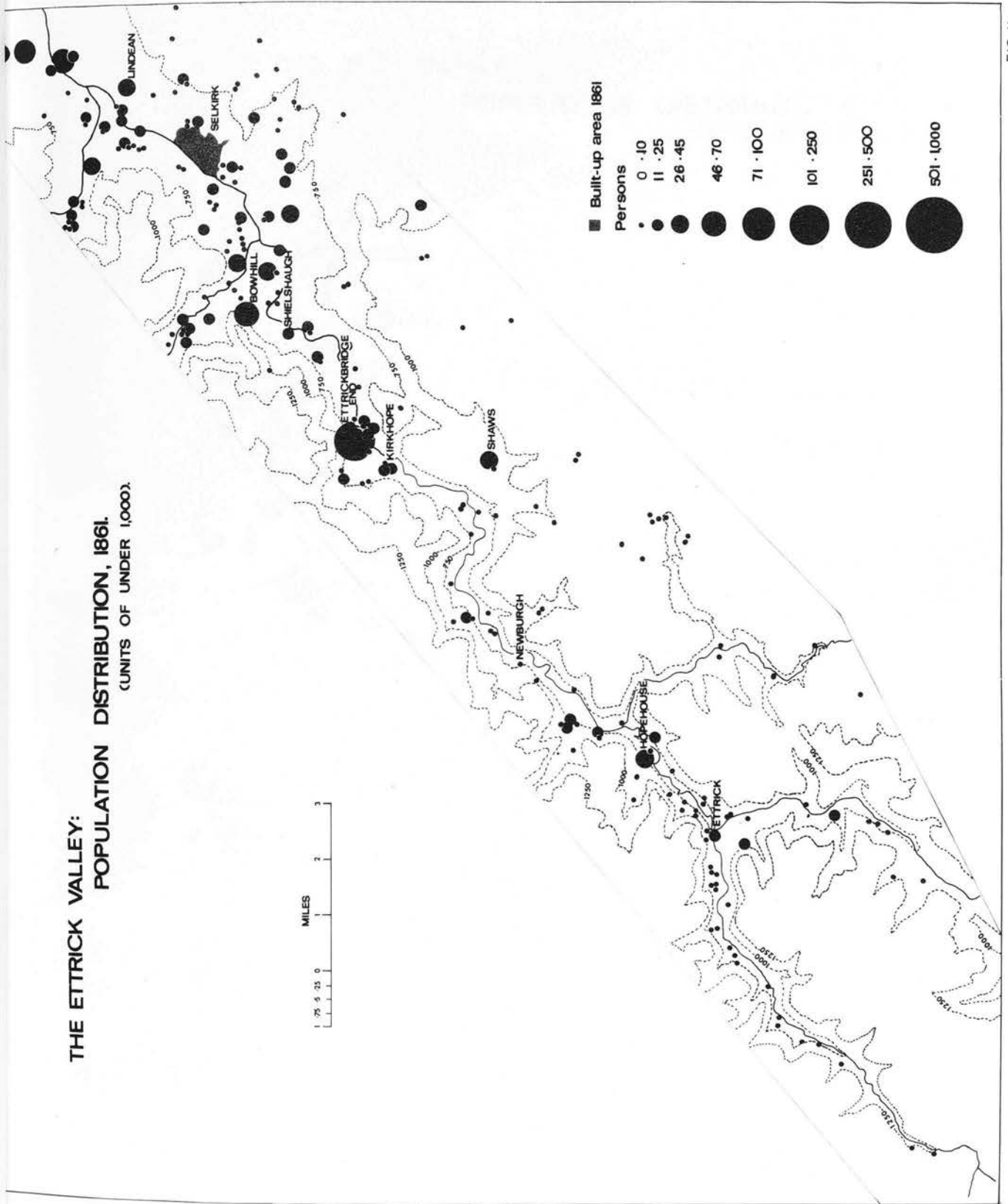
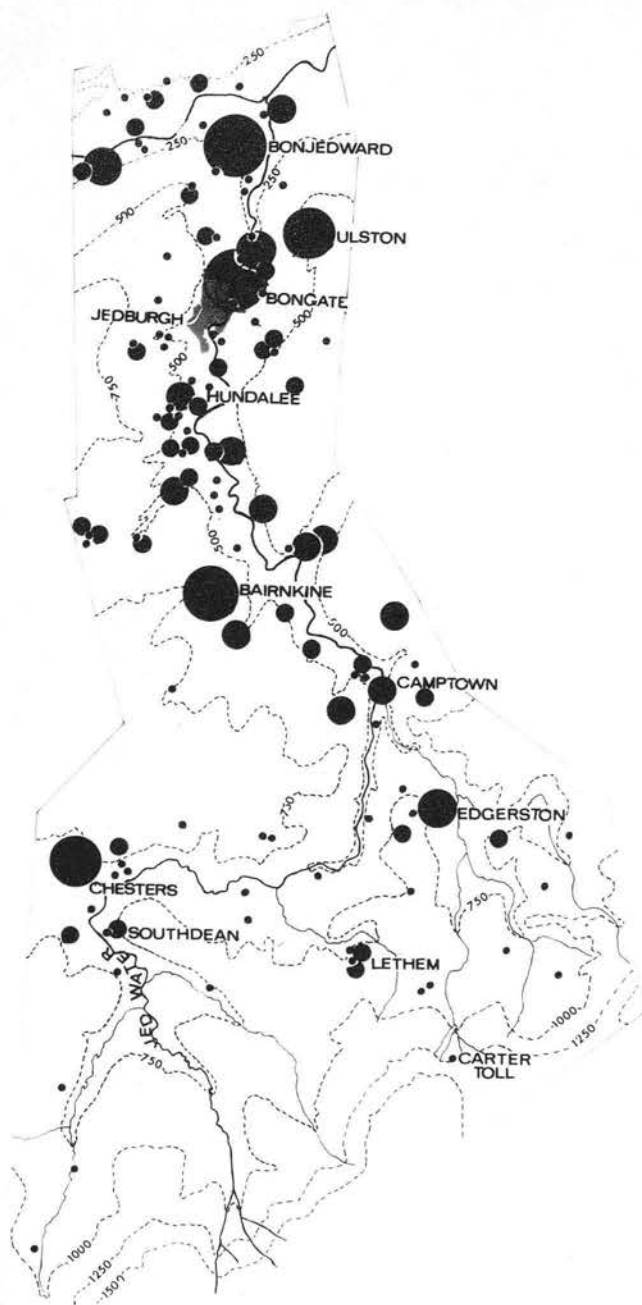

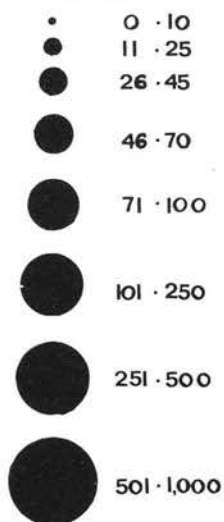

(UNITS OF UNDER 1000).

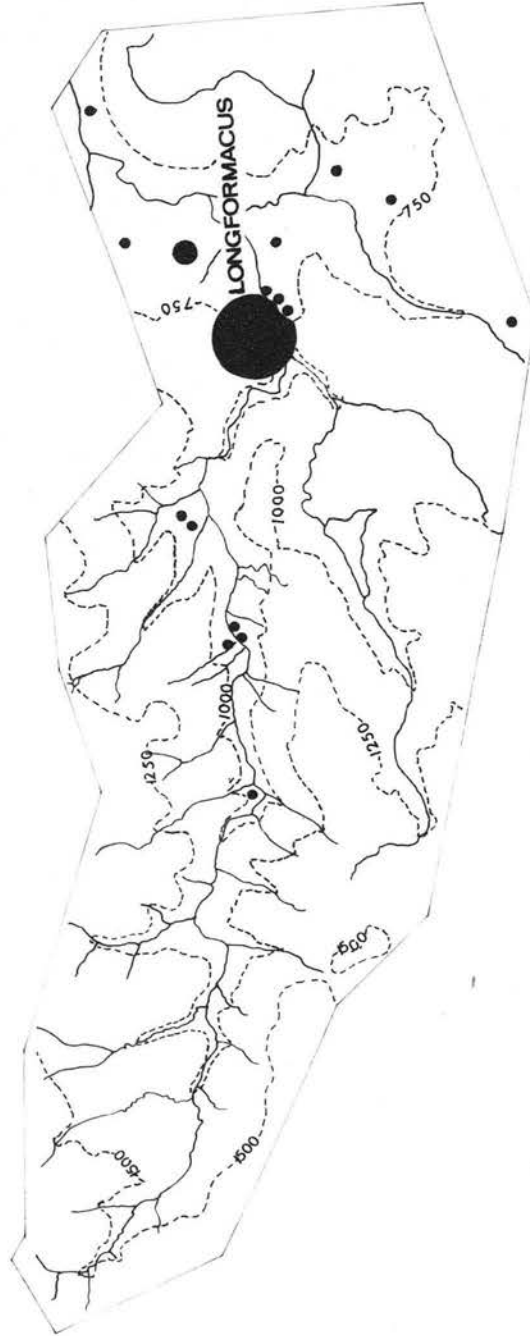
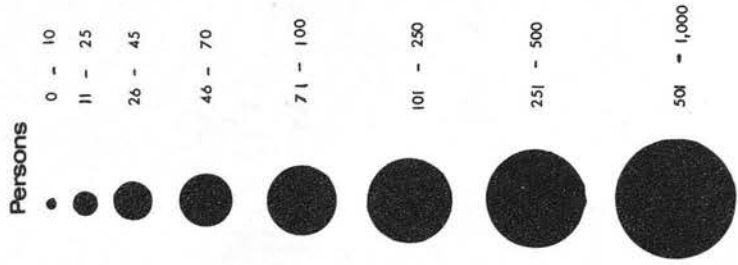

by parishes.

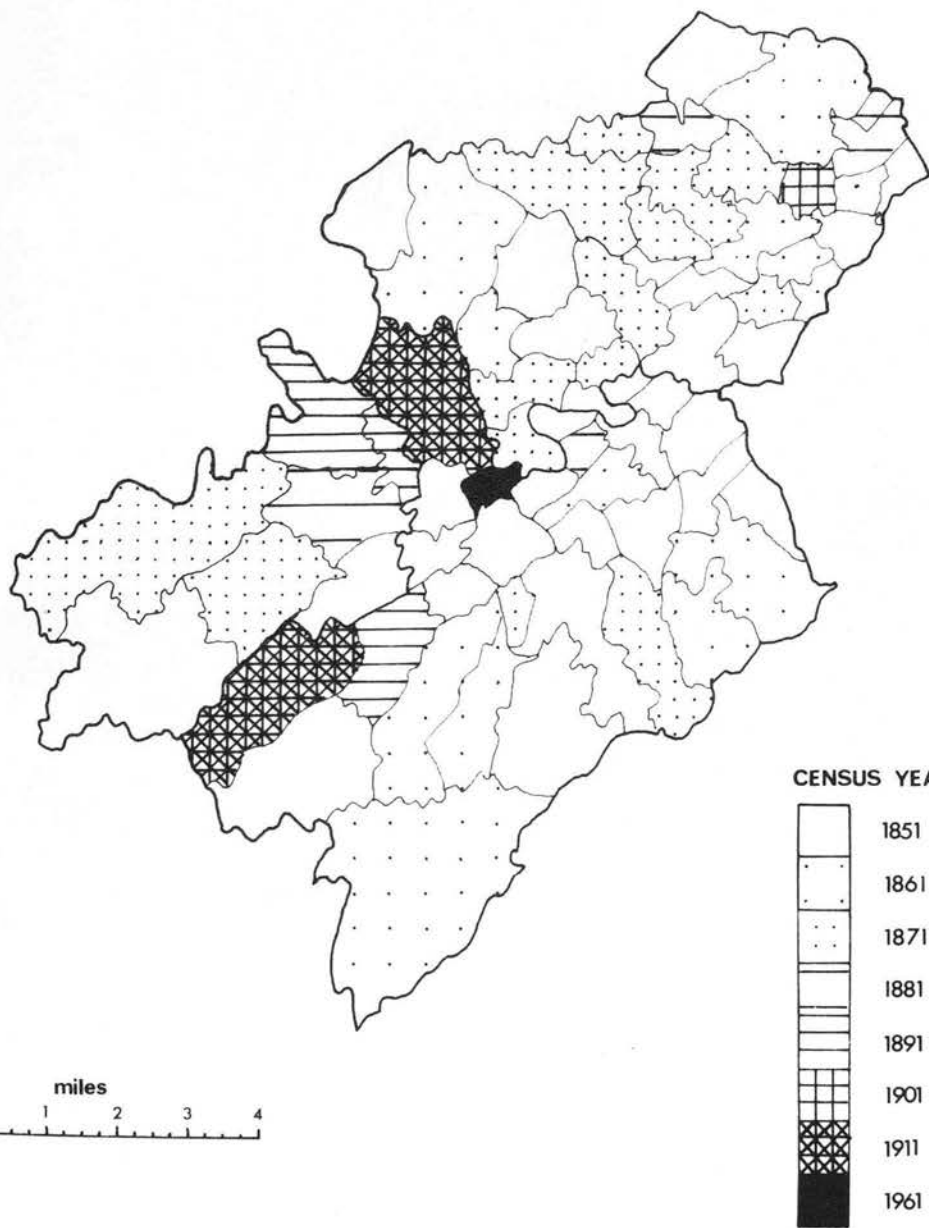

population decline, 1851-1961.**

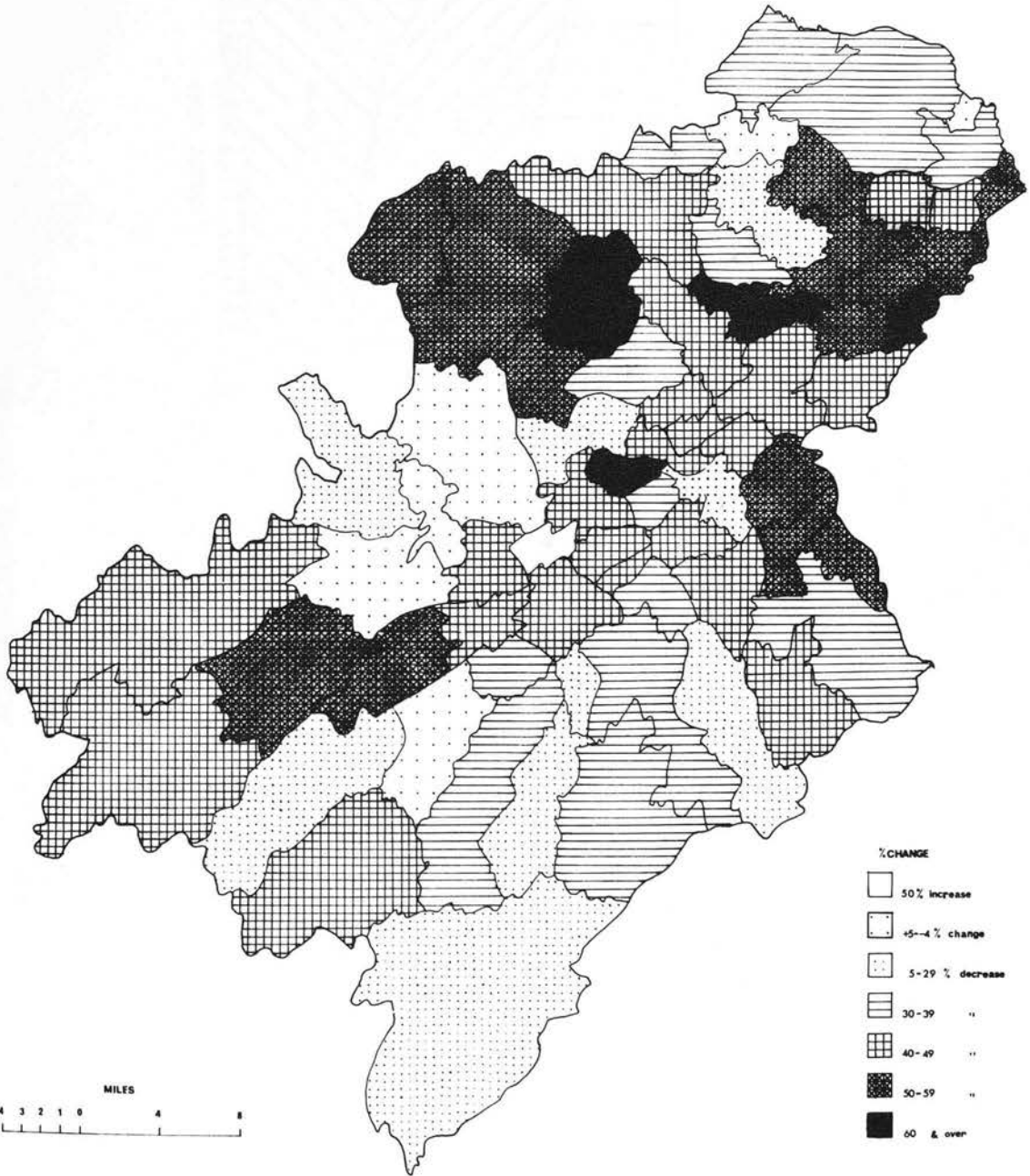

AGE GROUPS, 1851-1961.

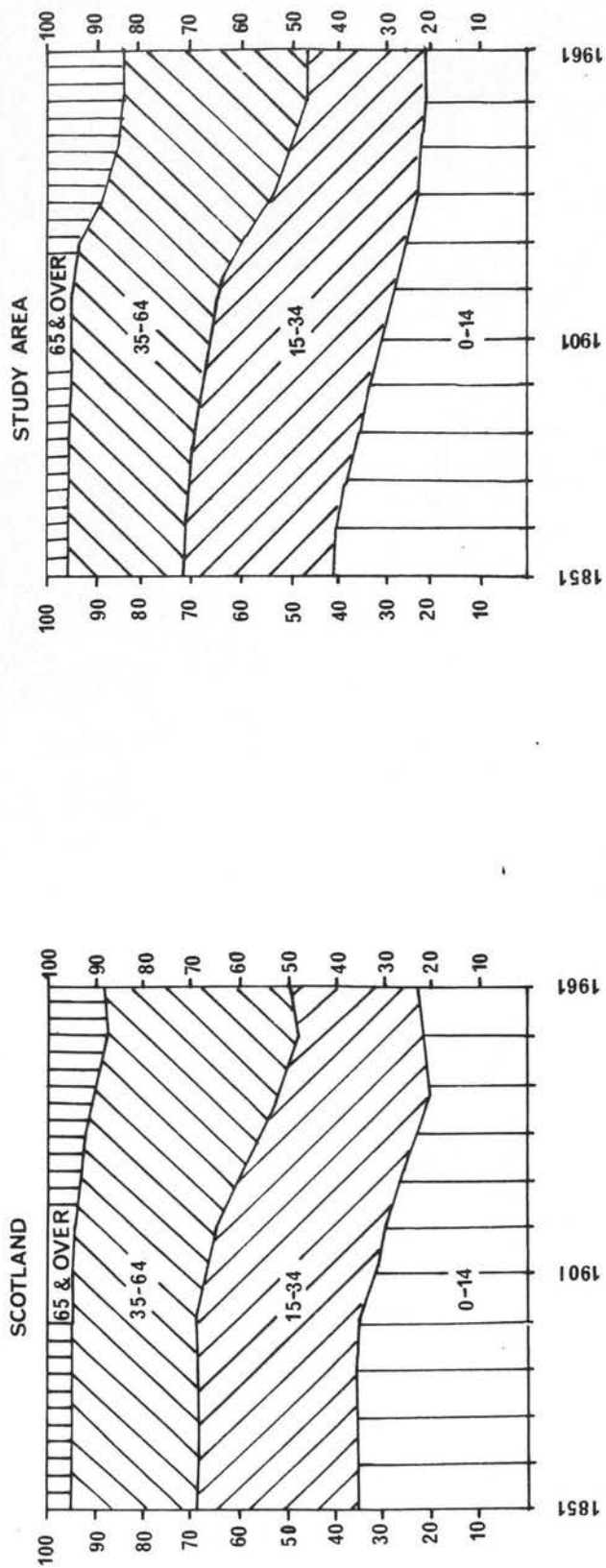
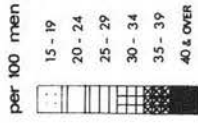
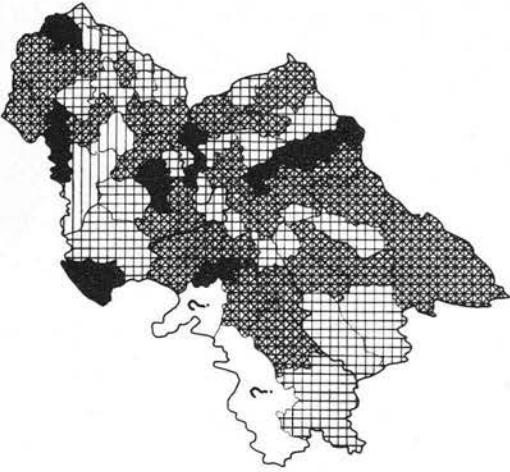

by parishes.**

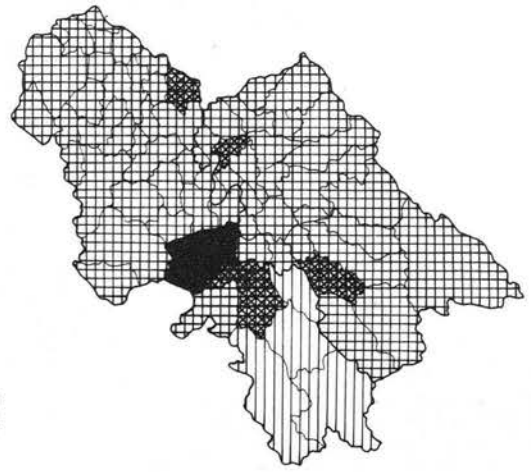

by parishes.

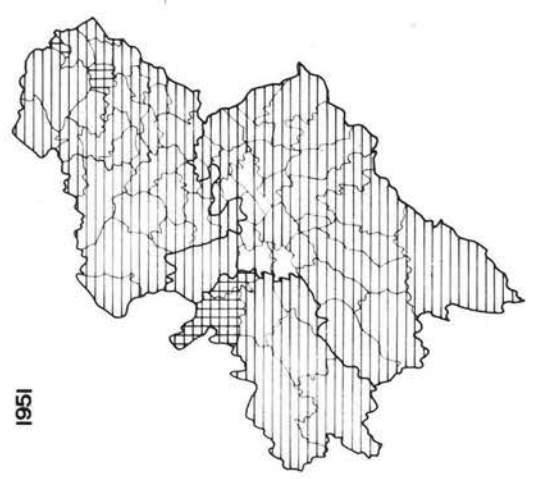
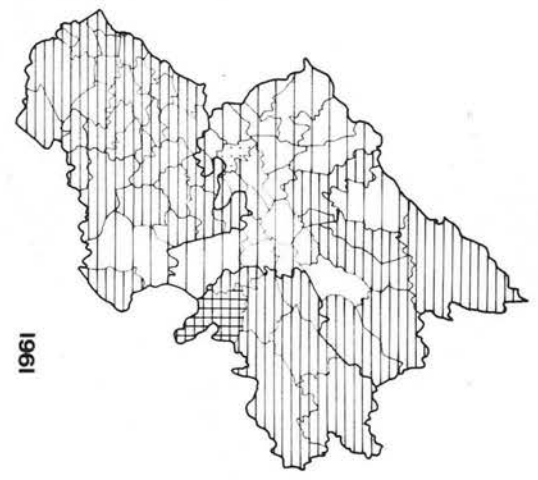
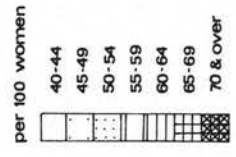
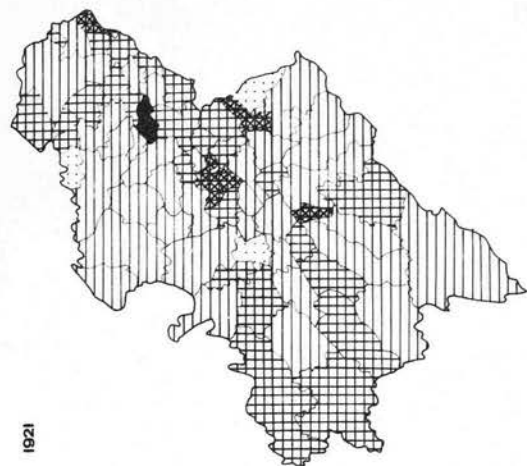
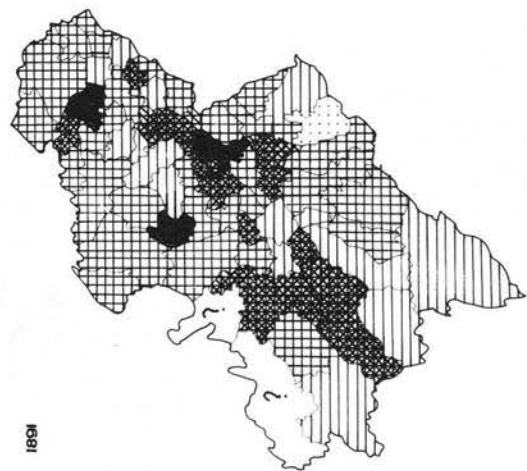

females aged 15-34.



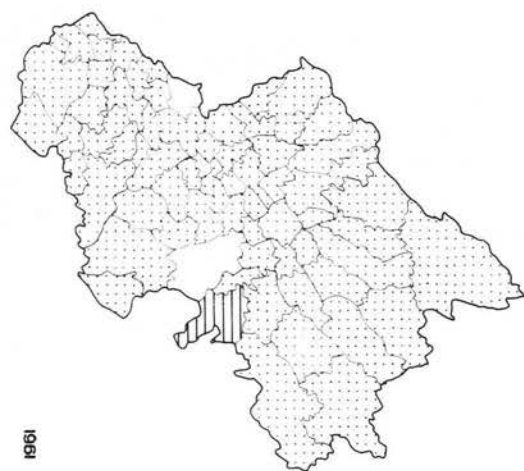

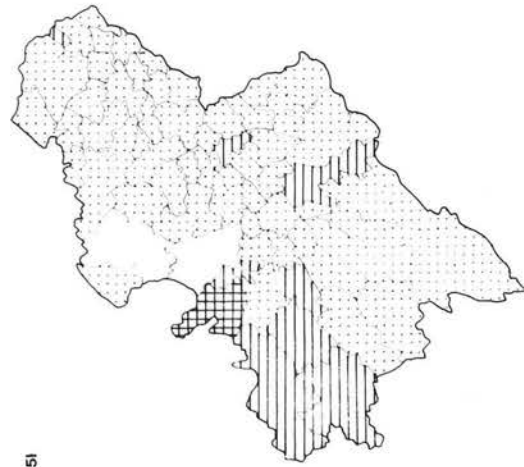

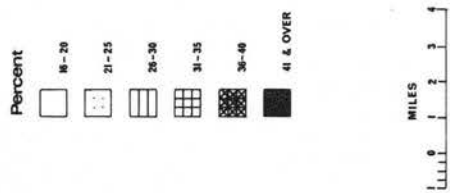

types of age structure change.

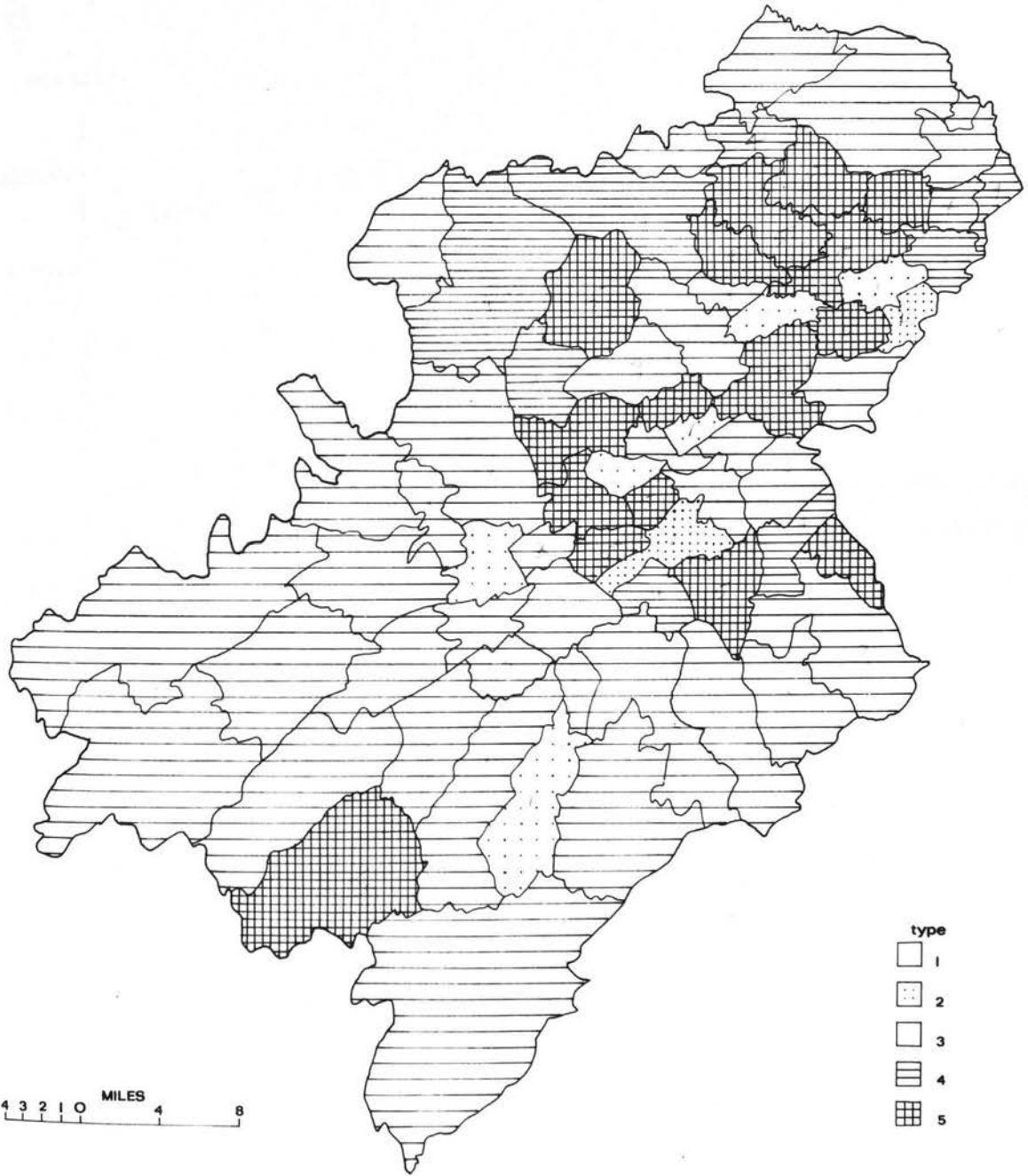

POPULATION GROWTH.

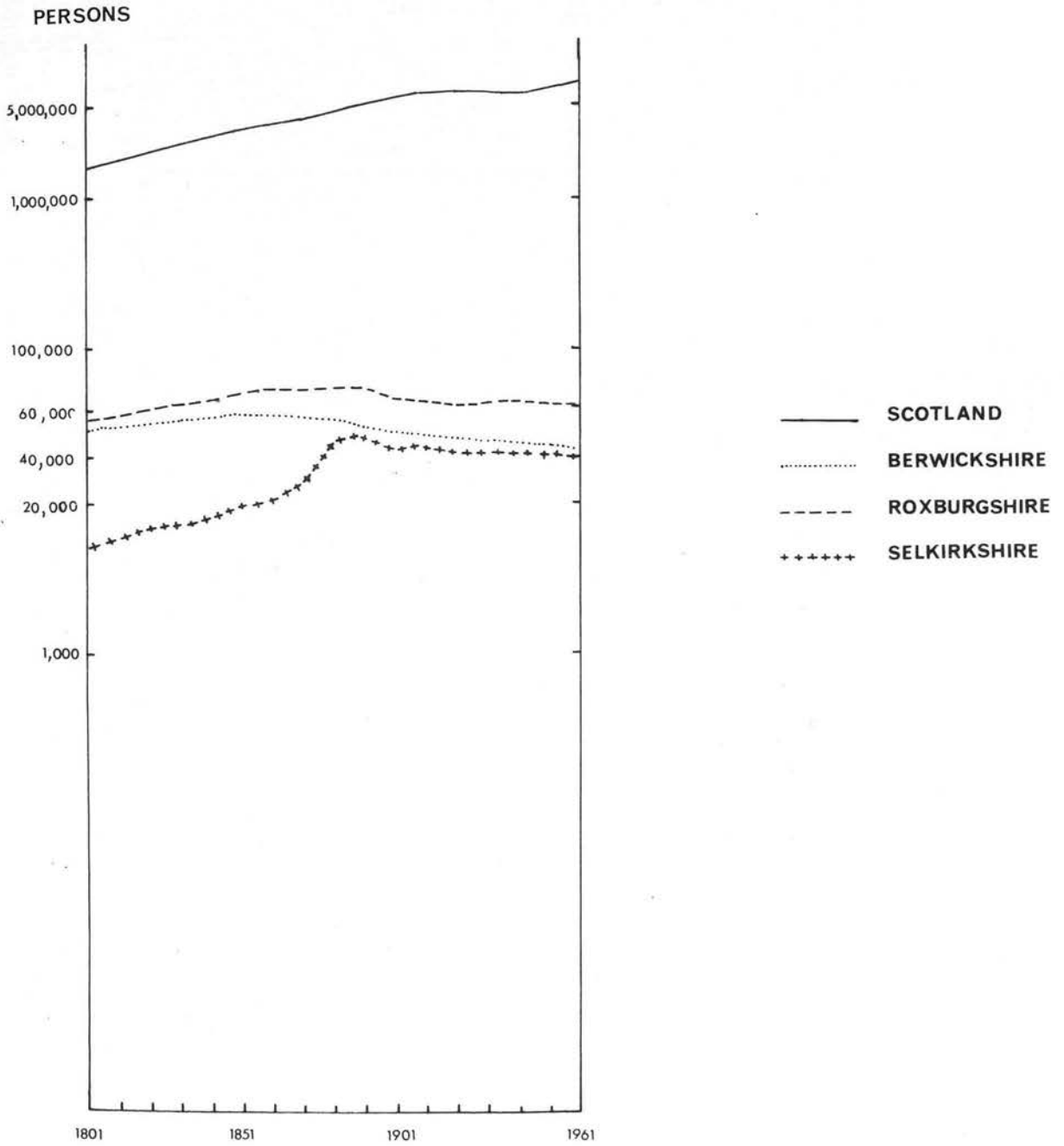
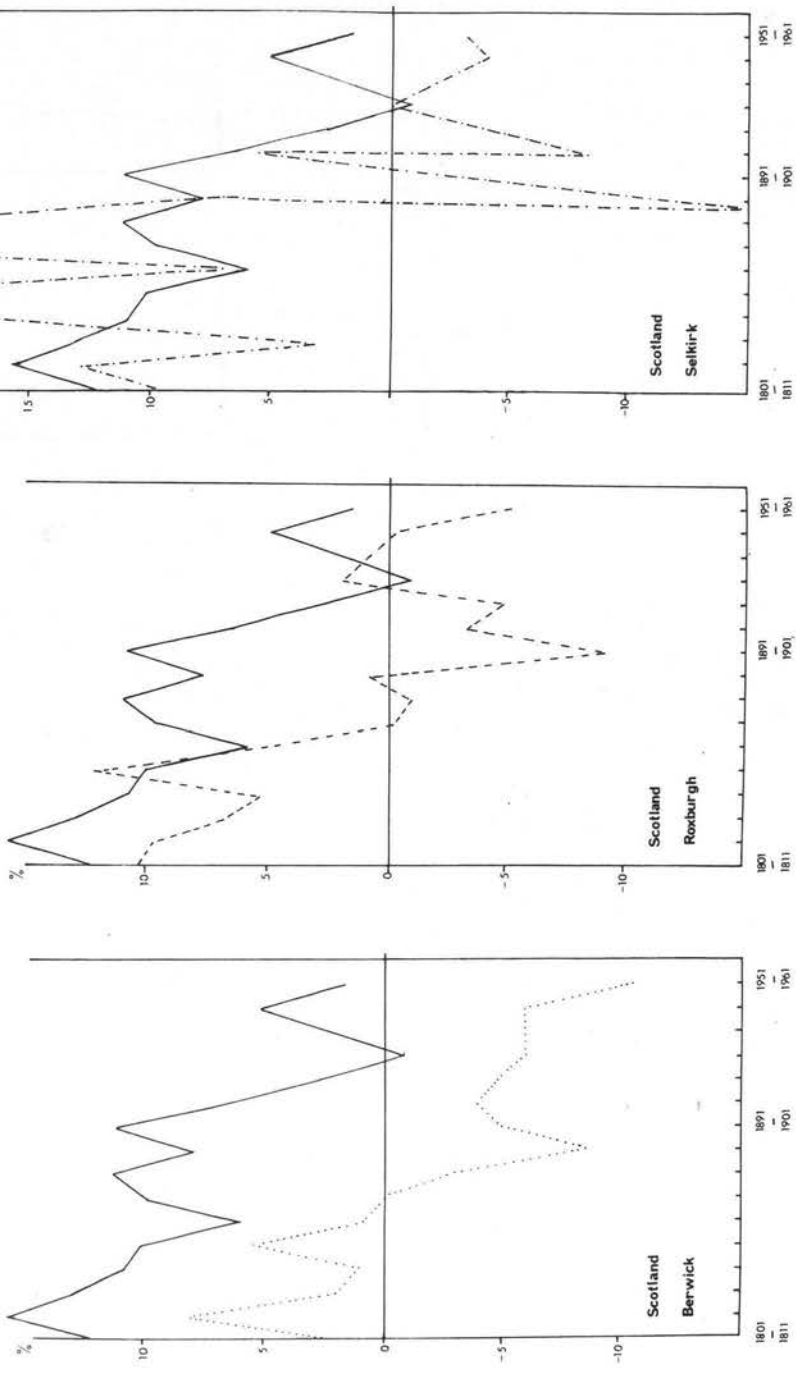

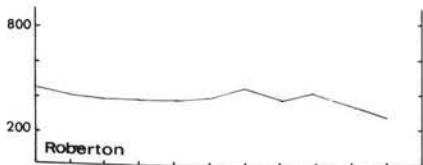
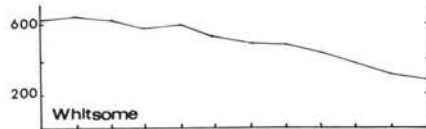
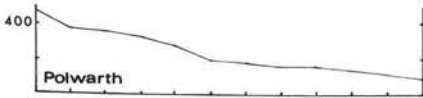
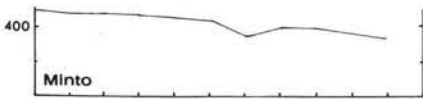
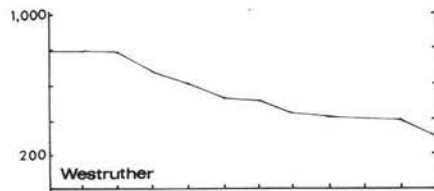
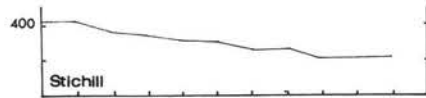
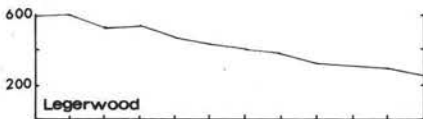
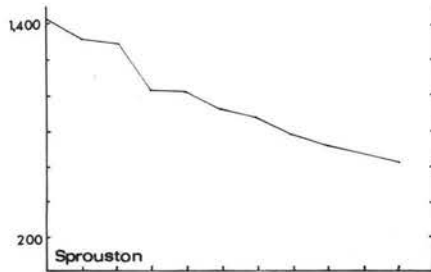
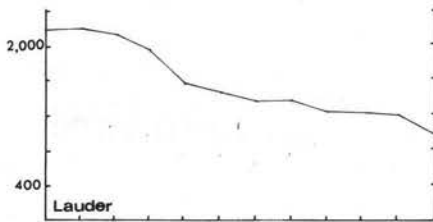
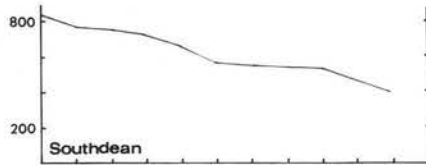
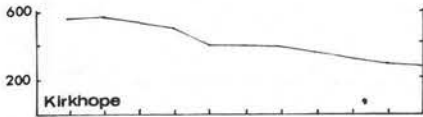
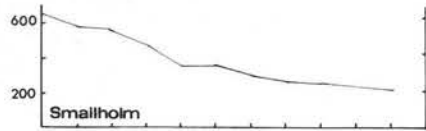
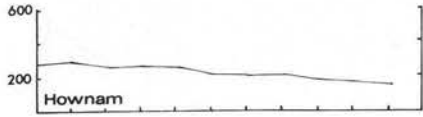
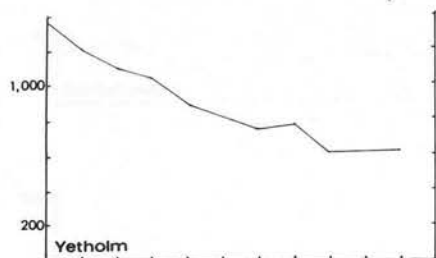
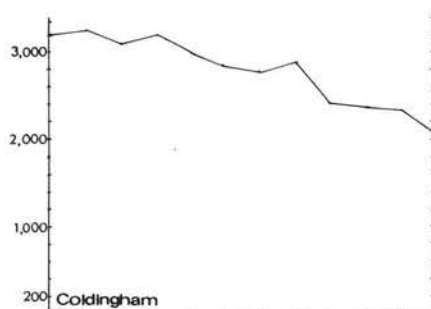
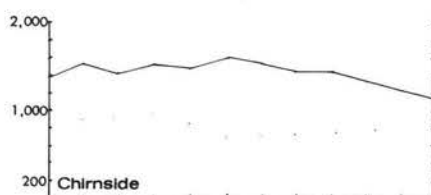
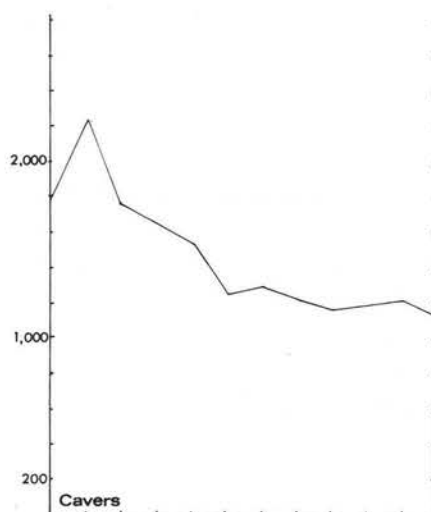
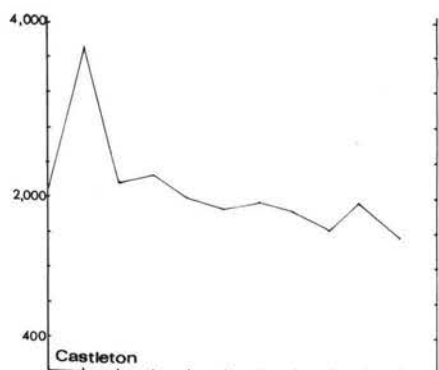
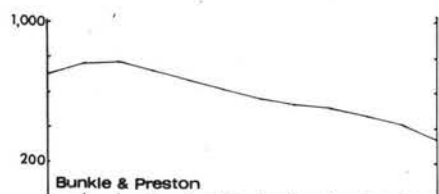
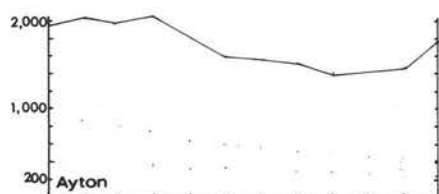
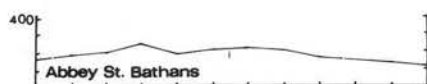


FIG. 36. CONTD.

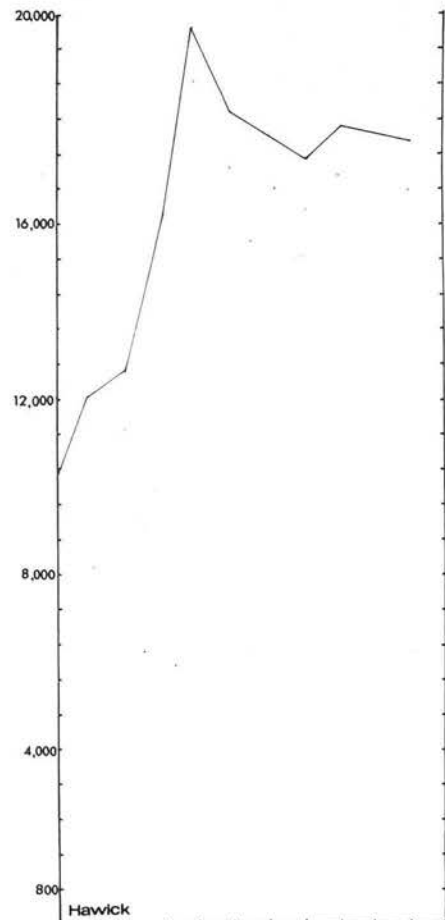
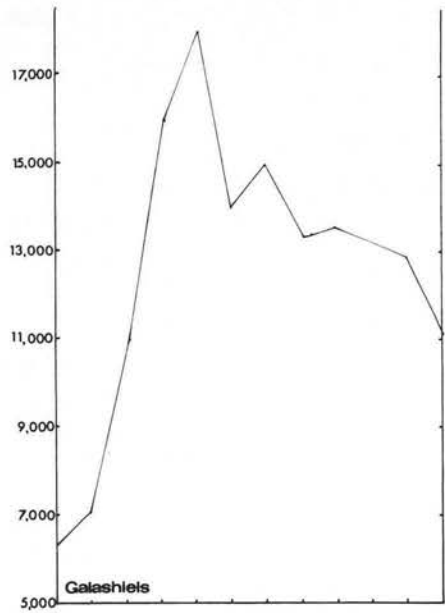
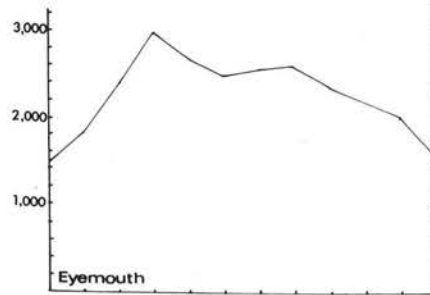
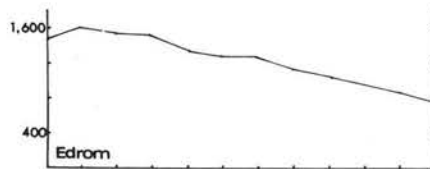
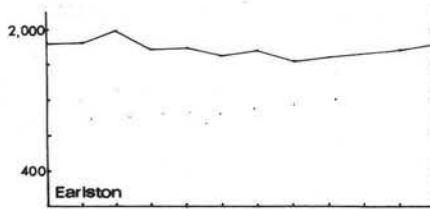
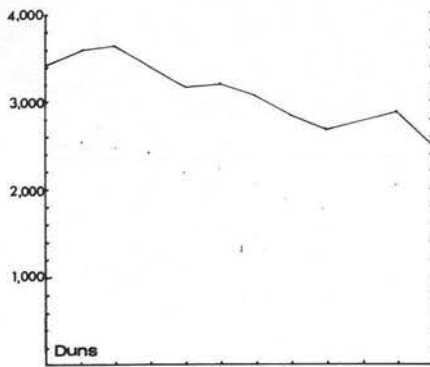


FIG. 36. CONTD.

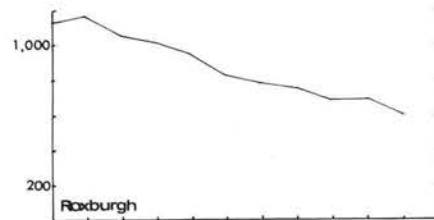
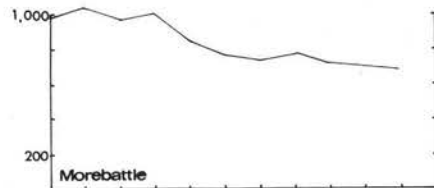
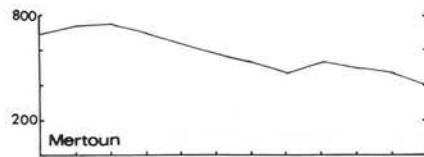
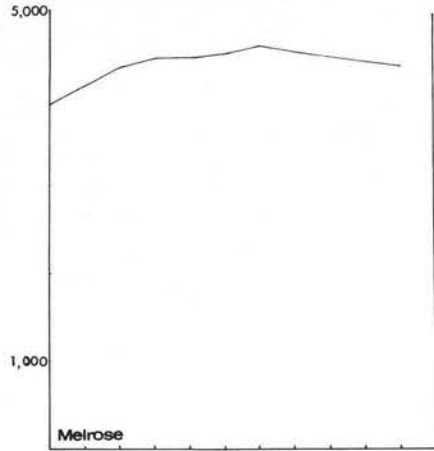
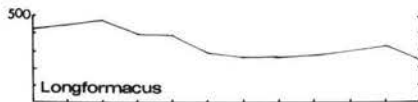
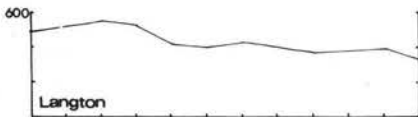
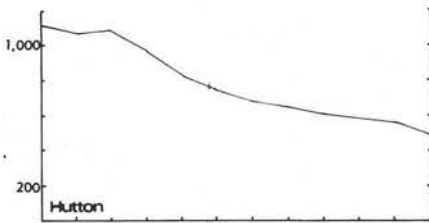
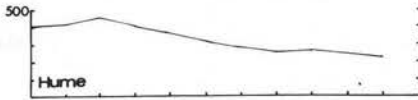
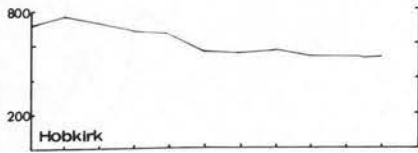
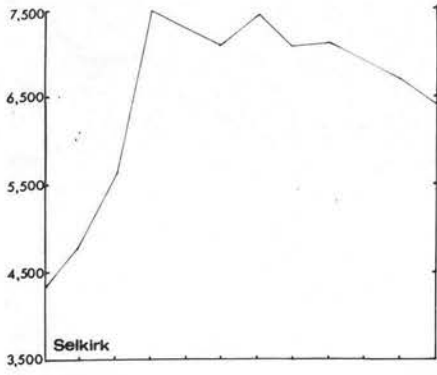
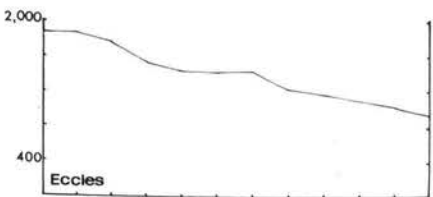
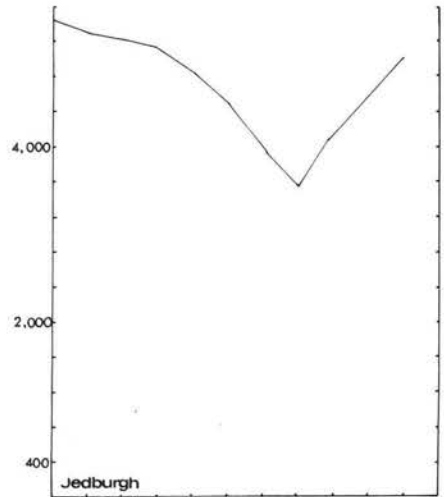
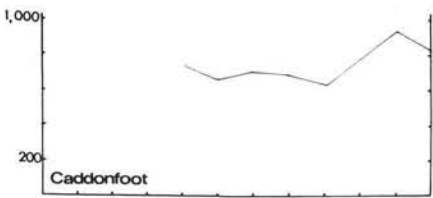
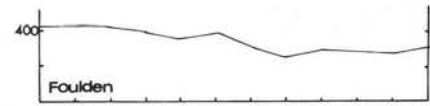
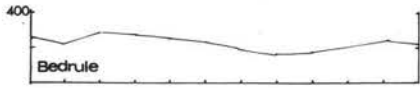
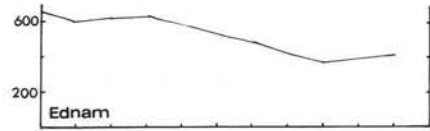
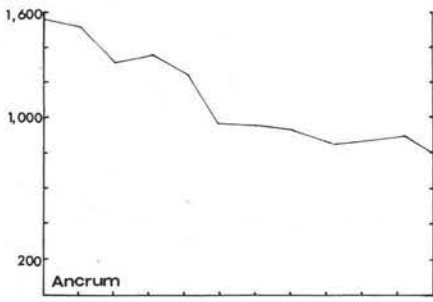


FIG. 36. CONTD.

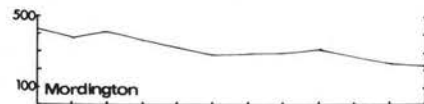
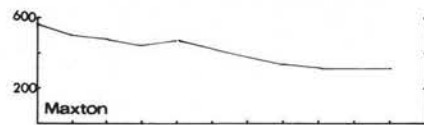
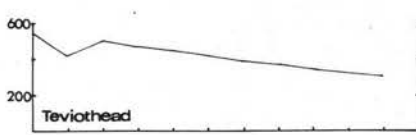
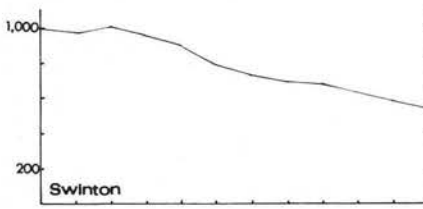
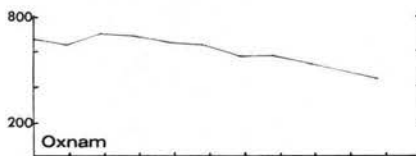
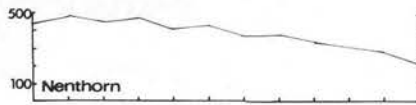
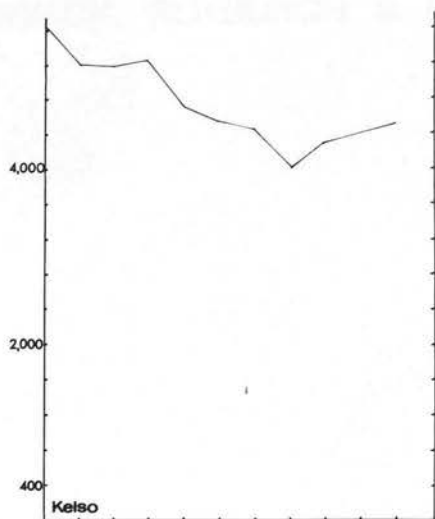

by parishes.

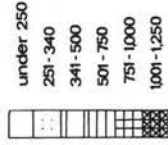
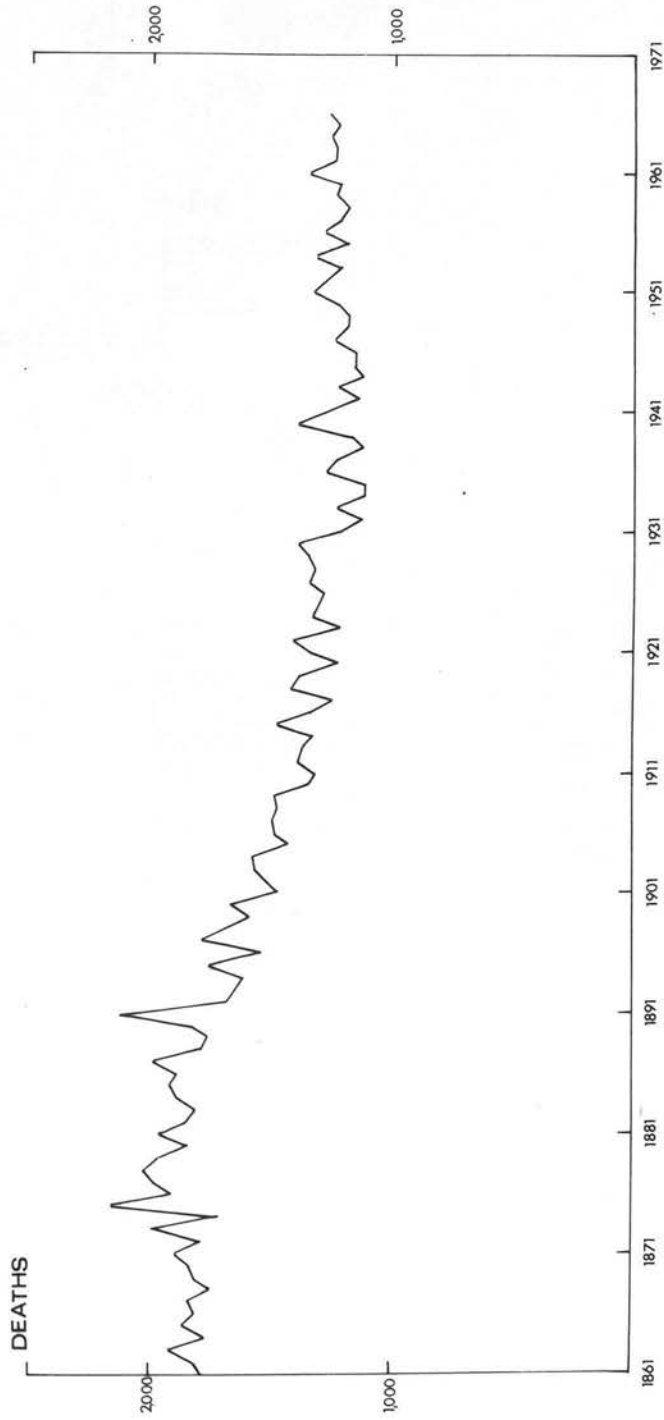

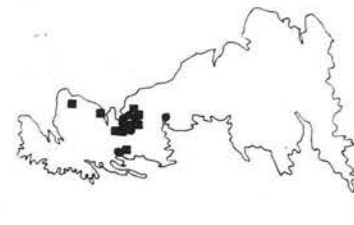
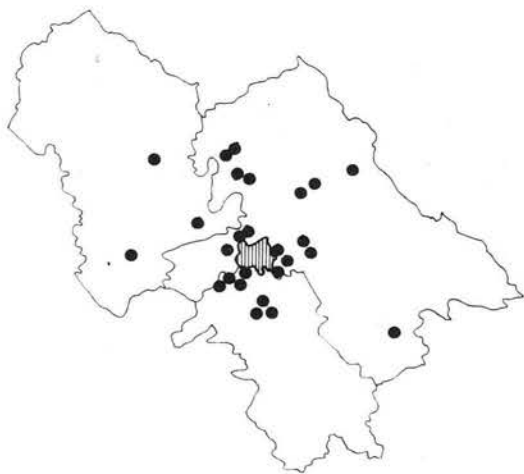
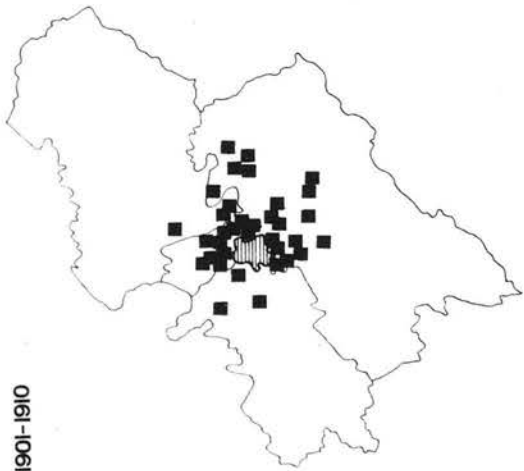
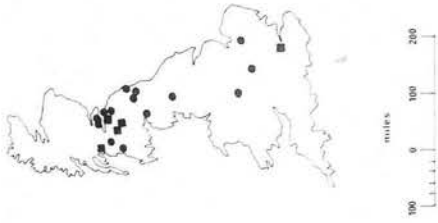
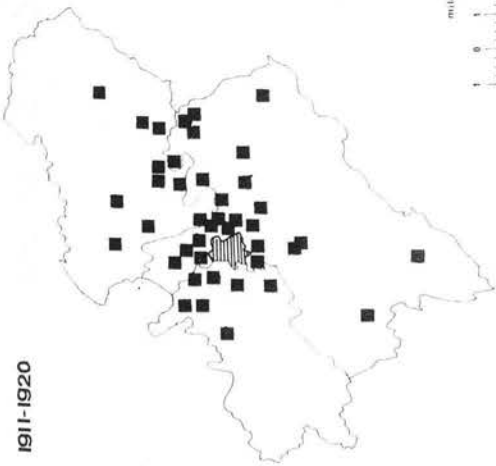


FIG. 46. CONTD.

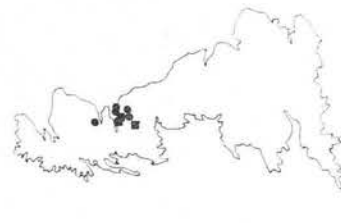
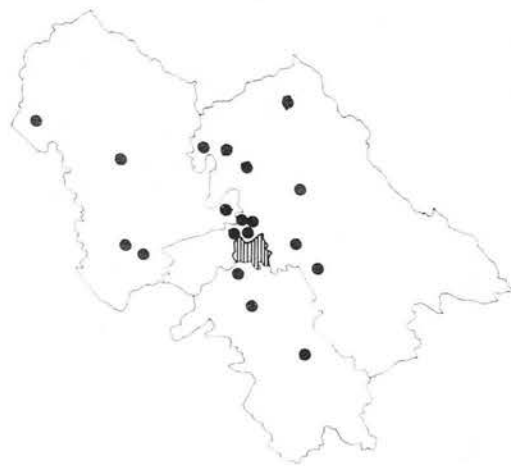
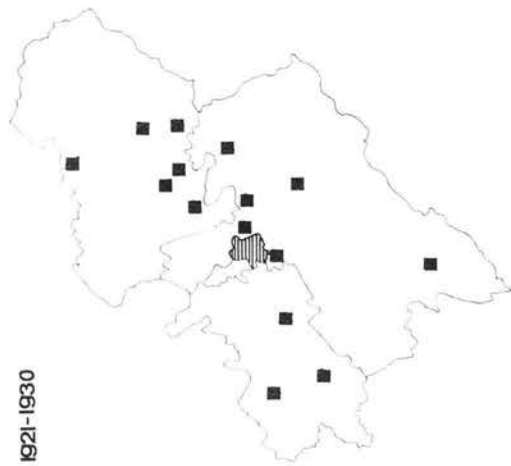

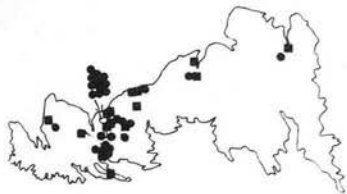
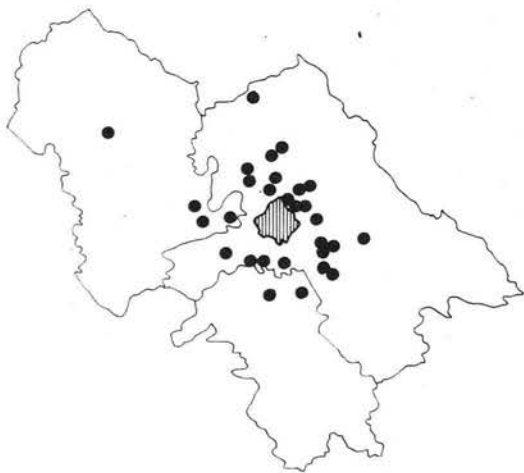
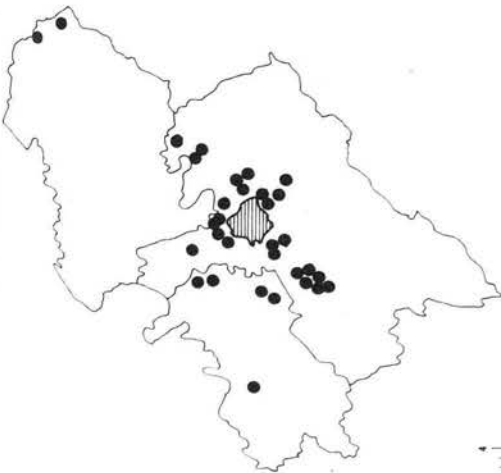
FIG. 52. CONTD.

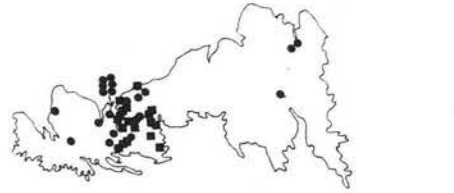
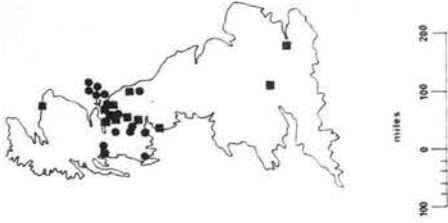
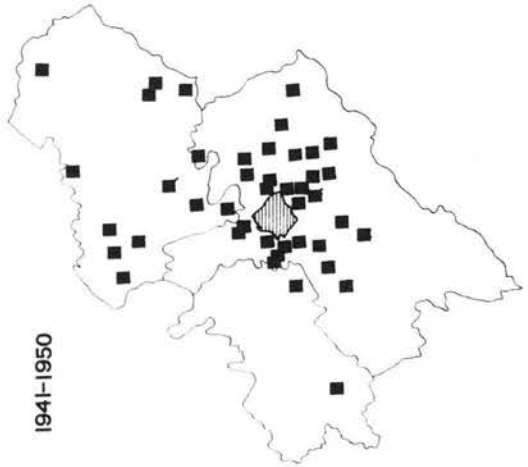
FIG. 52. CONTD.

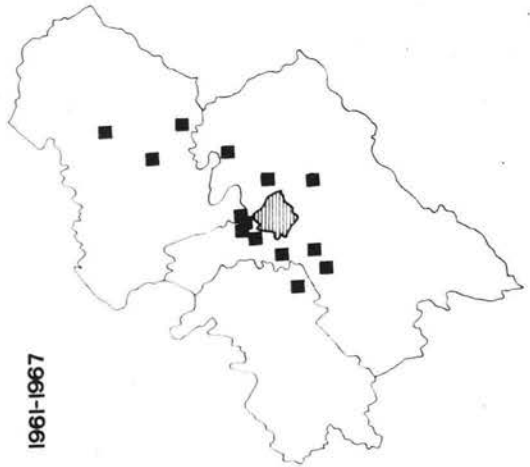
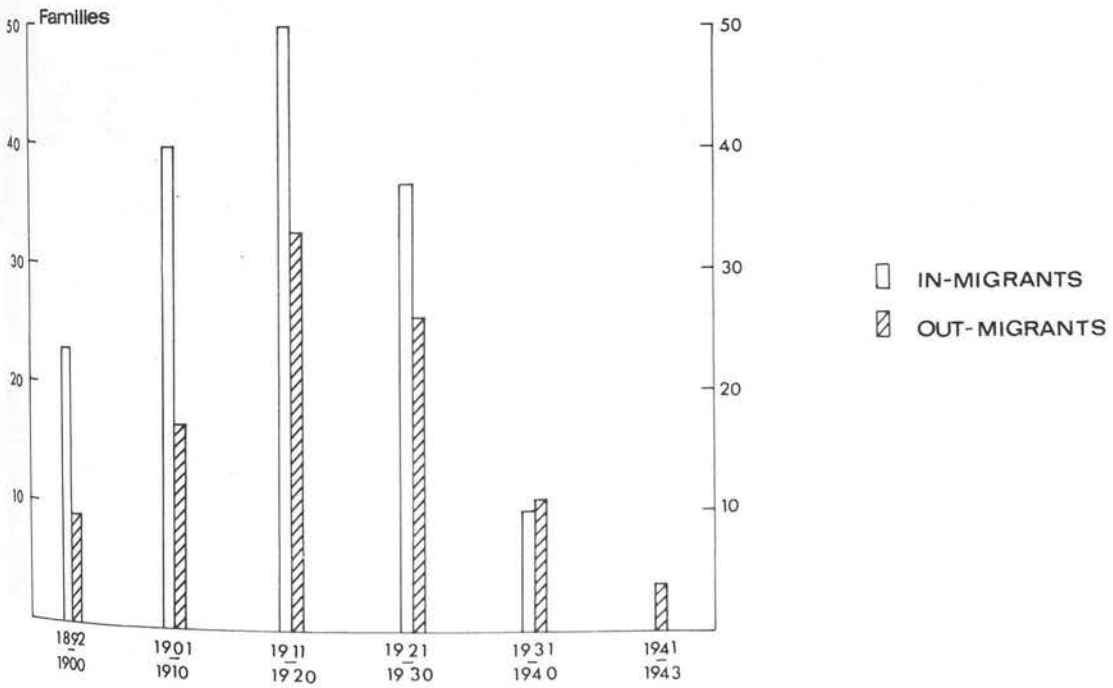
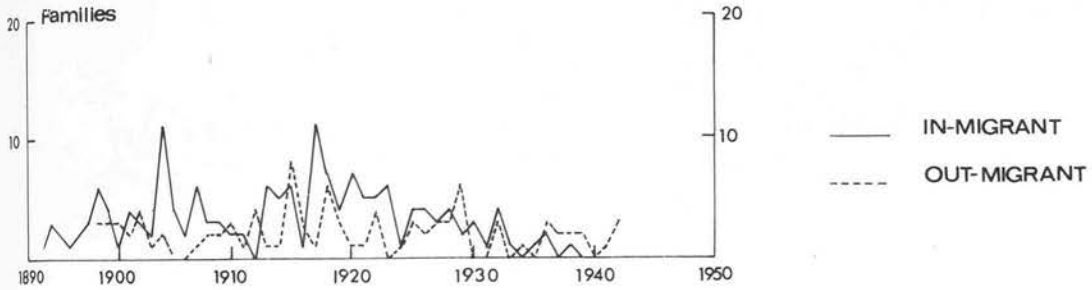


FIG. 52. CONTD.

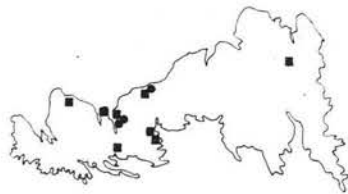
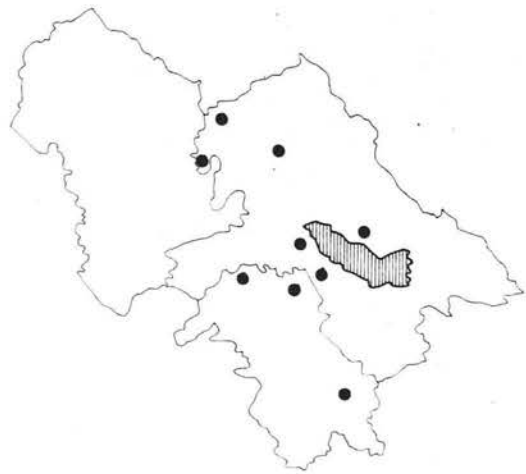
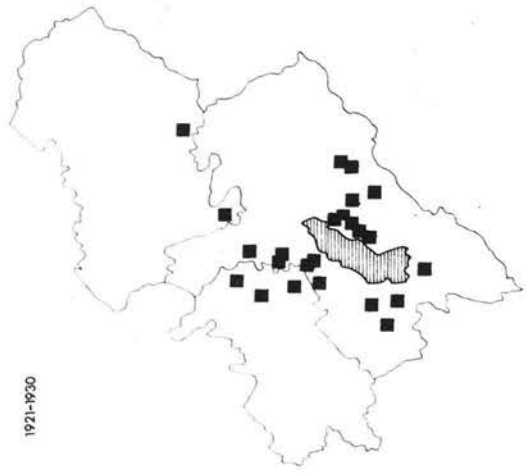
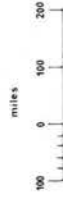
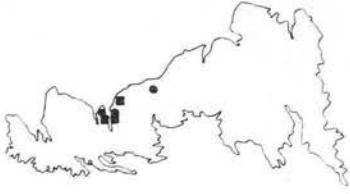
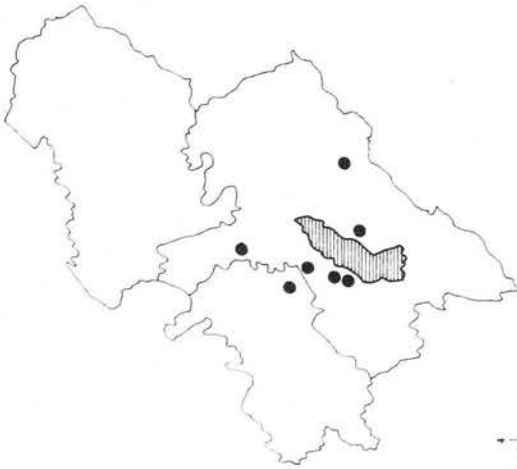
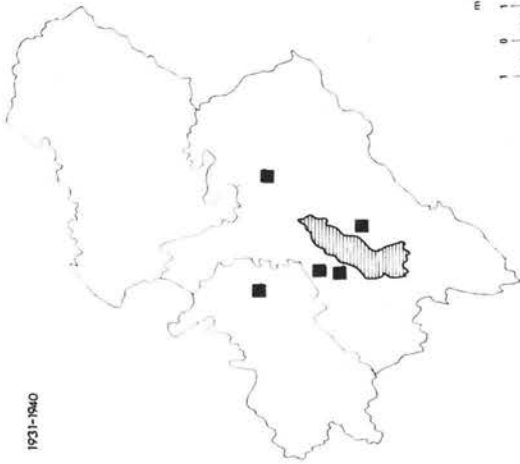


FIG. 54. CONTD.

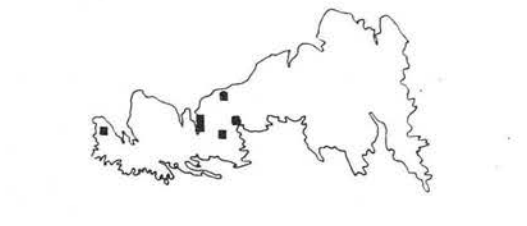
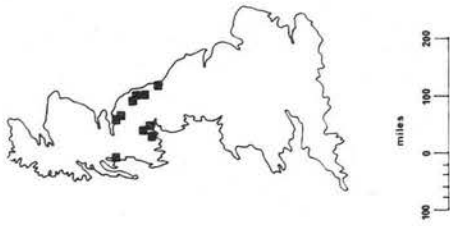
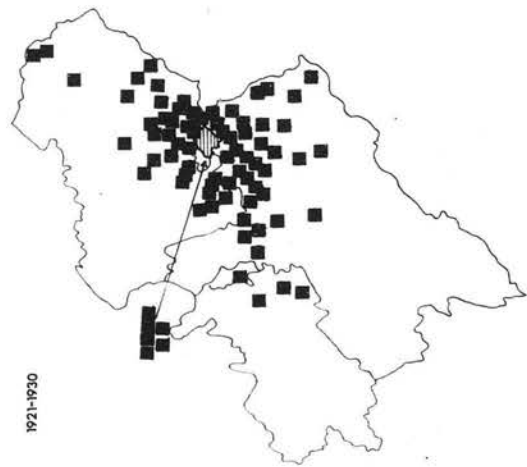
FIG. 58. CONT'D.

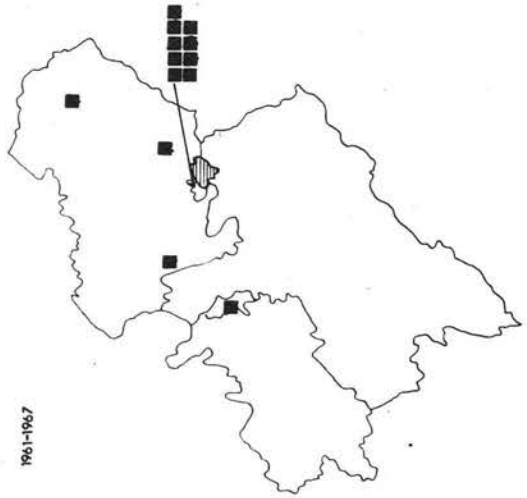
FIG. 58. CONTD.

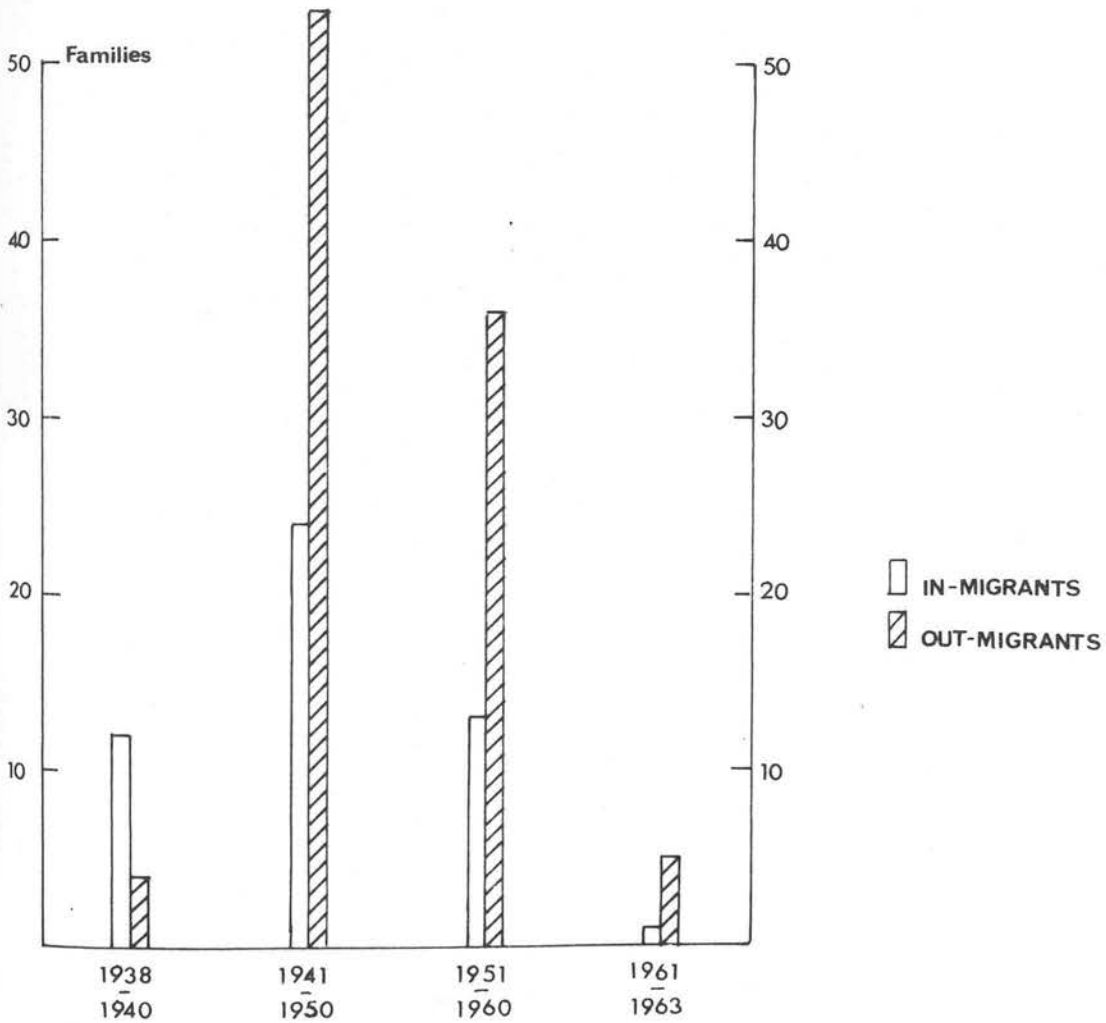
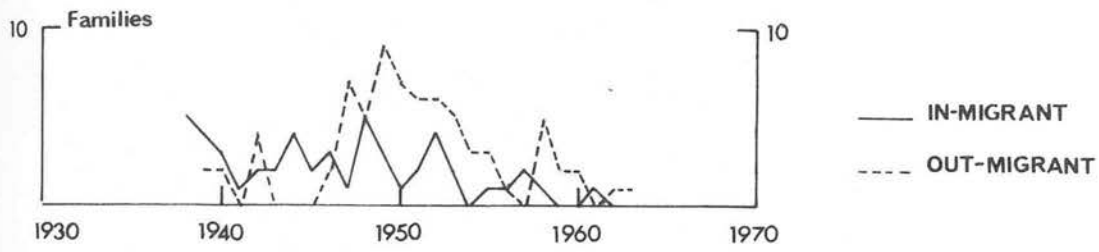
FIG. 60. CONTD.

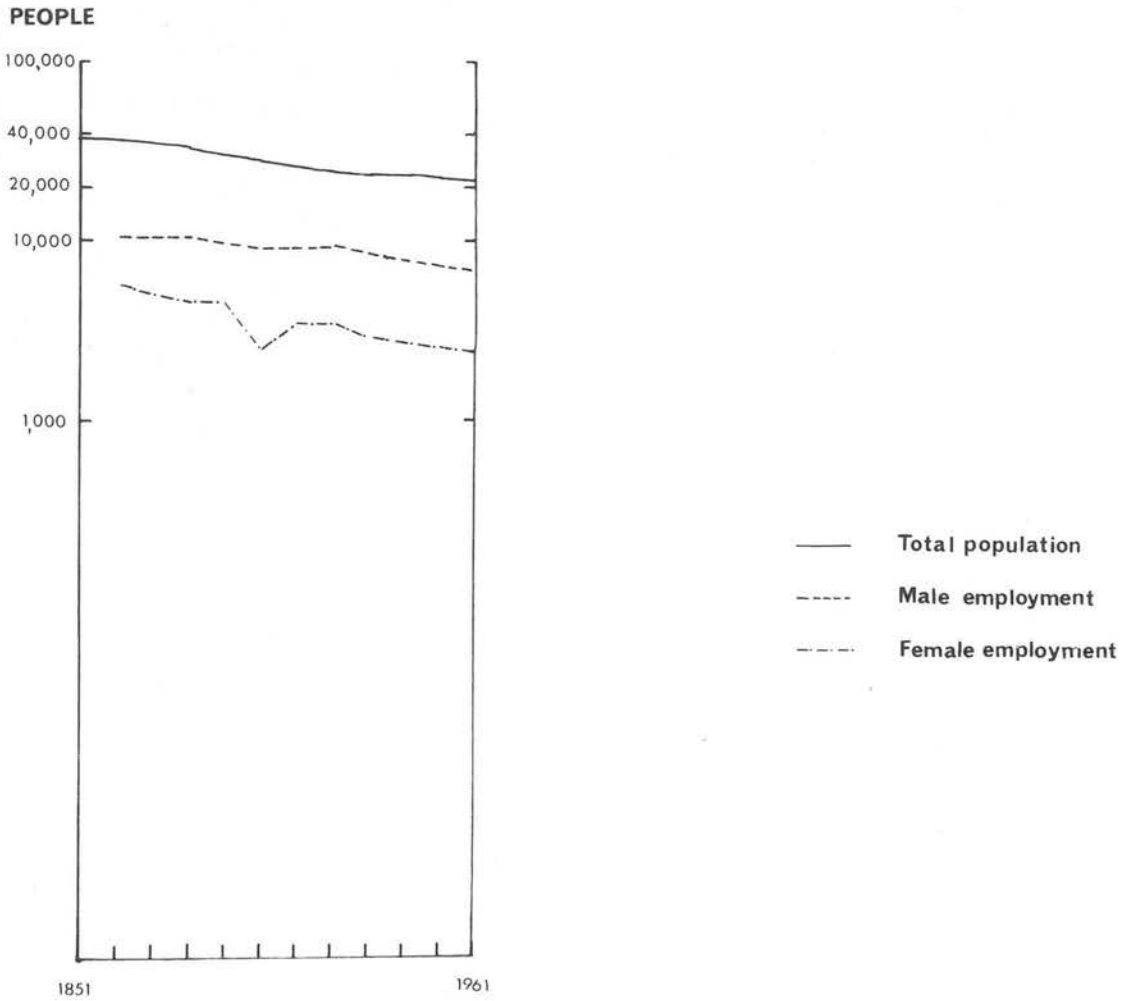

population & employment change.

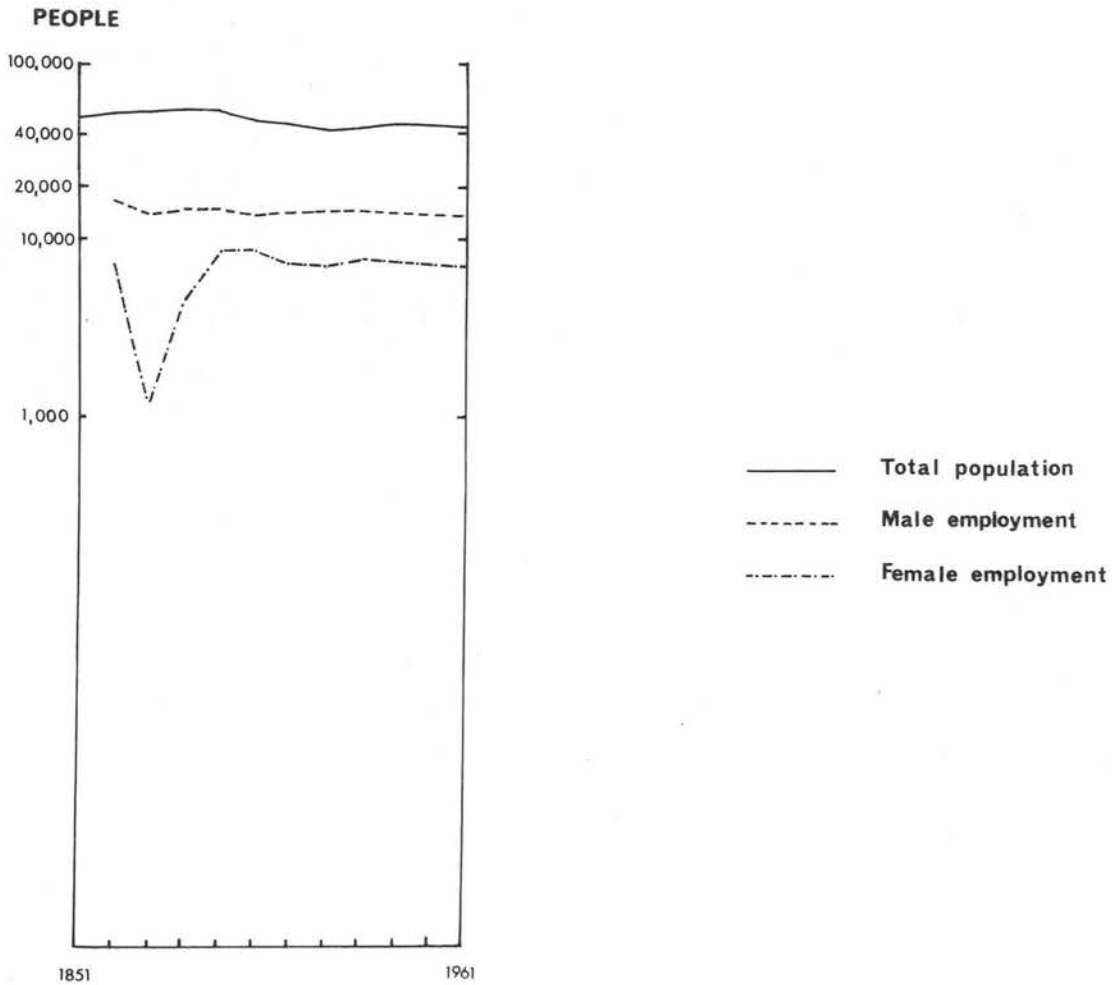

population & employment change.

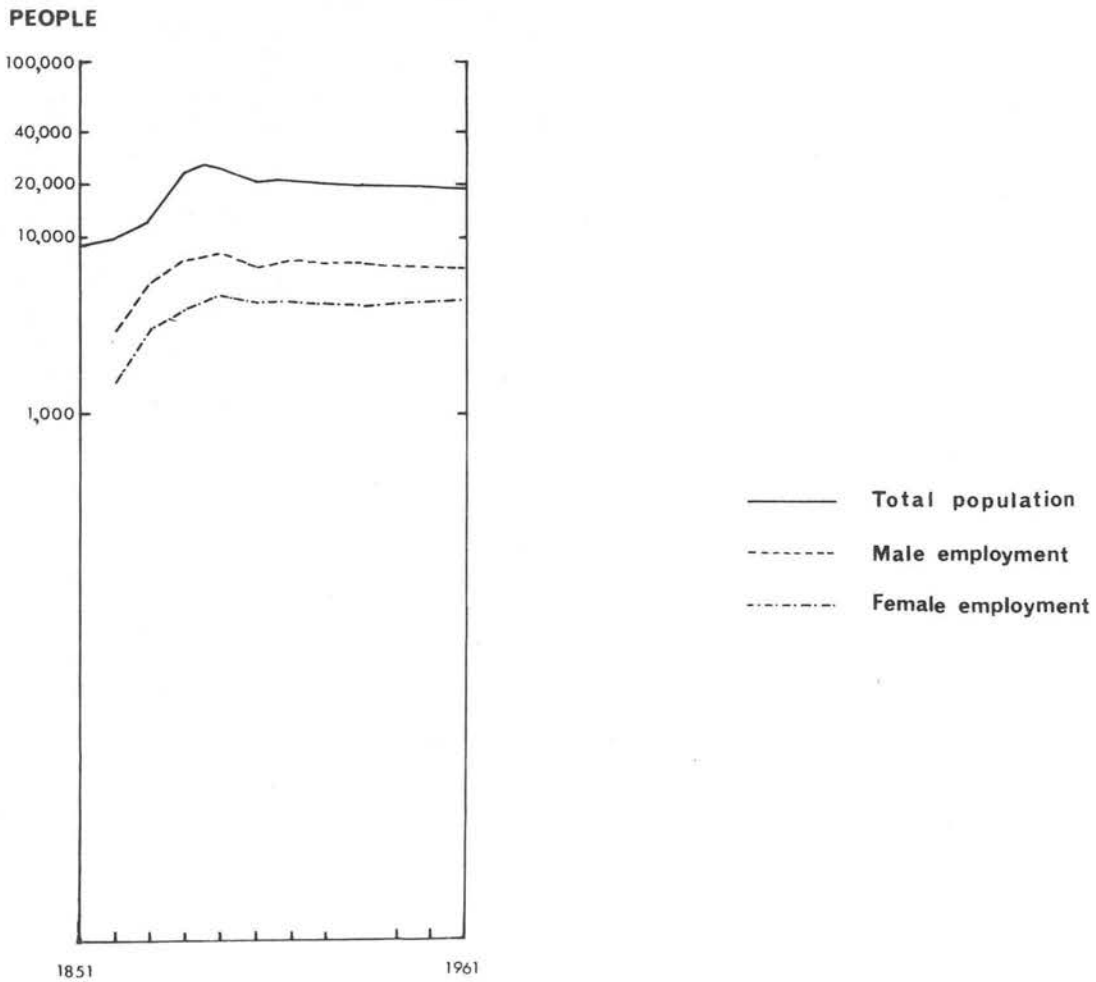

agricultural employment.**

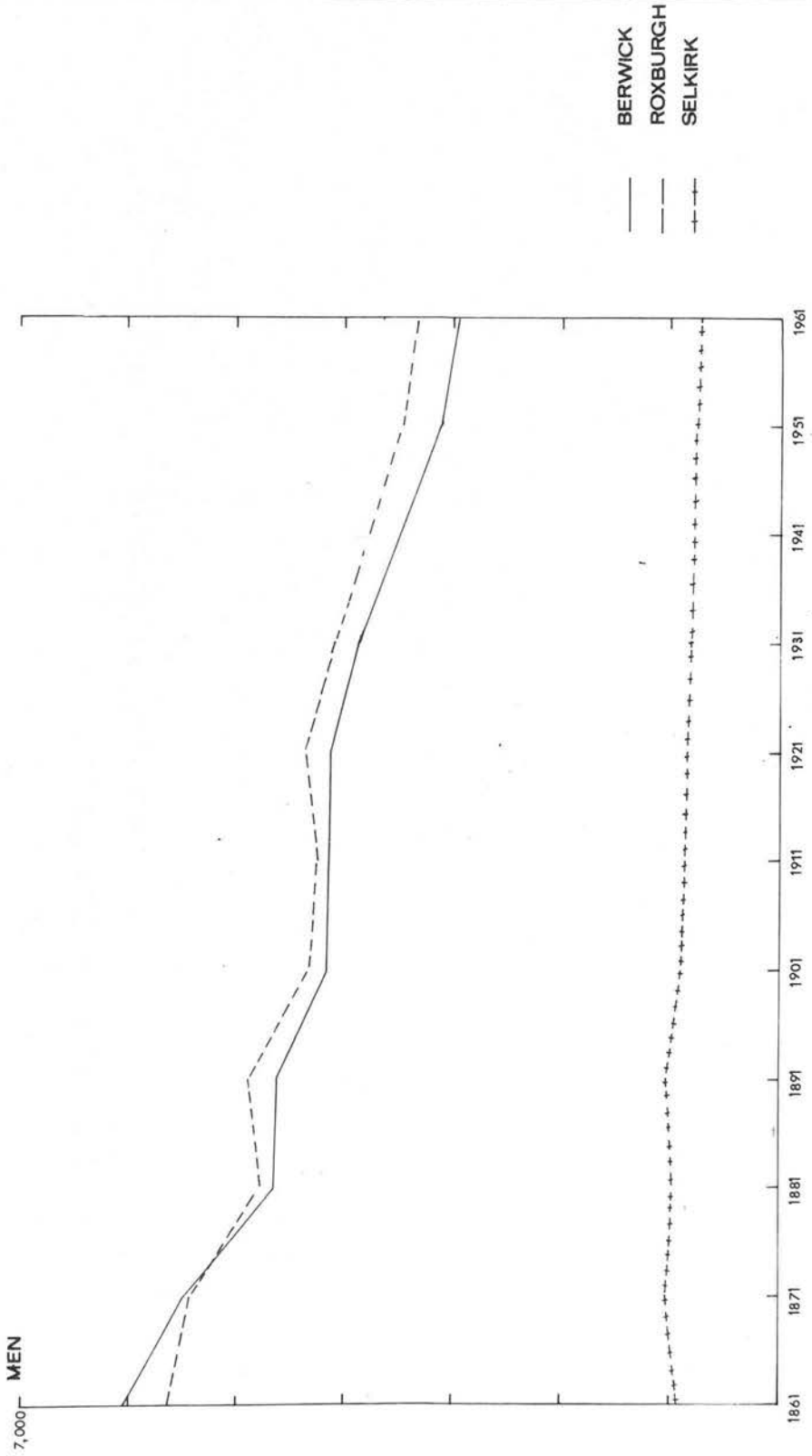

agricultural employment.

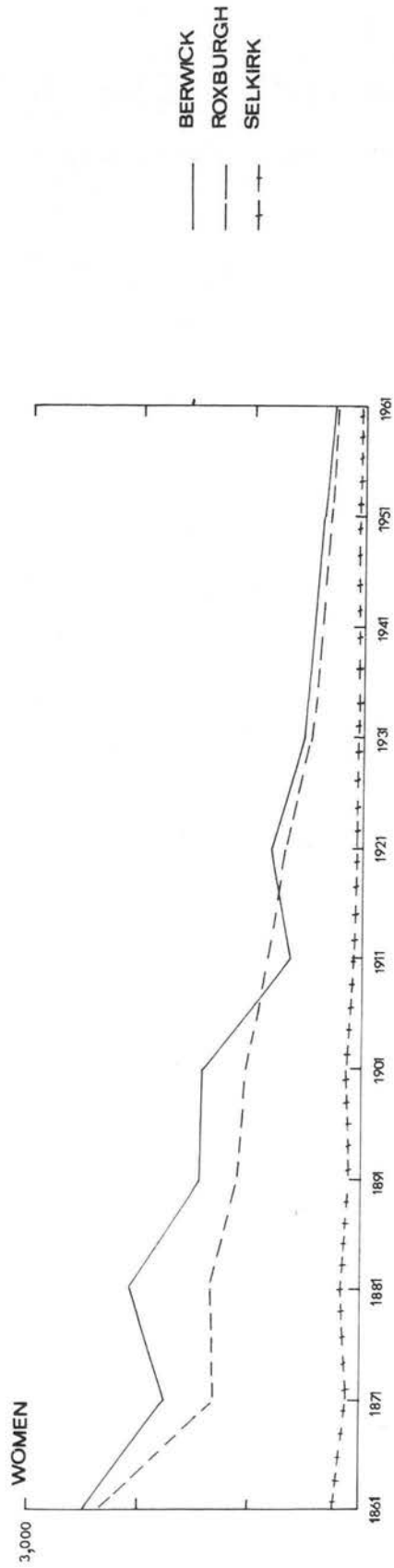

 acreage under crops and grass.

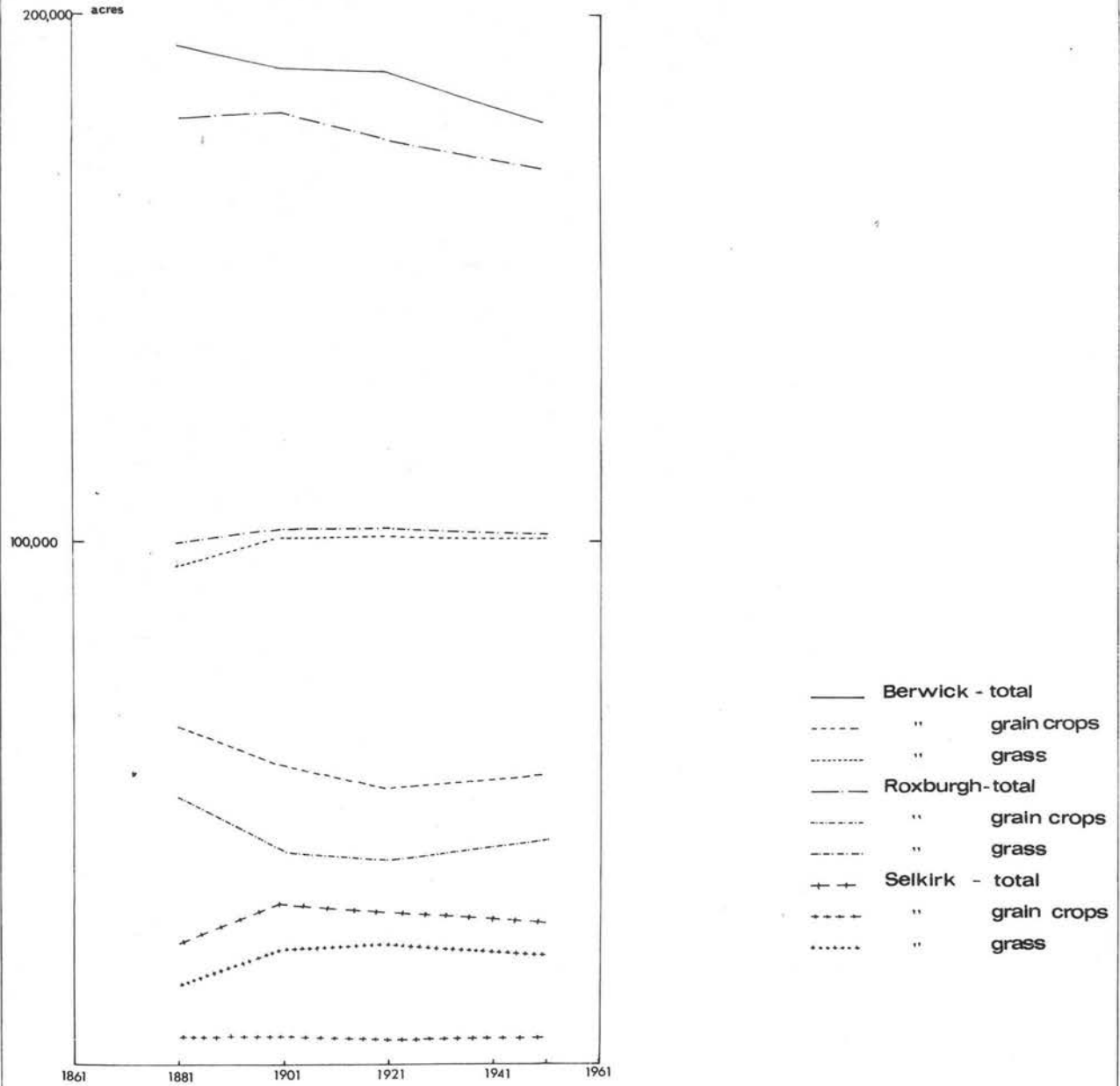

cattle totals.

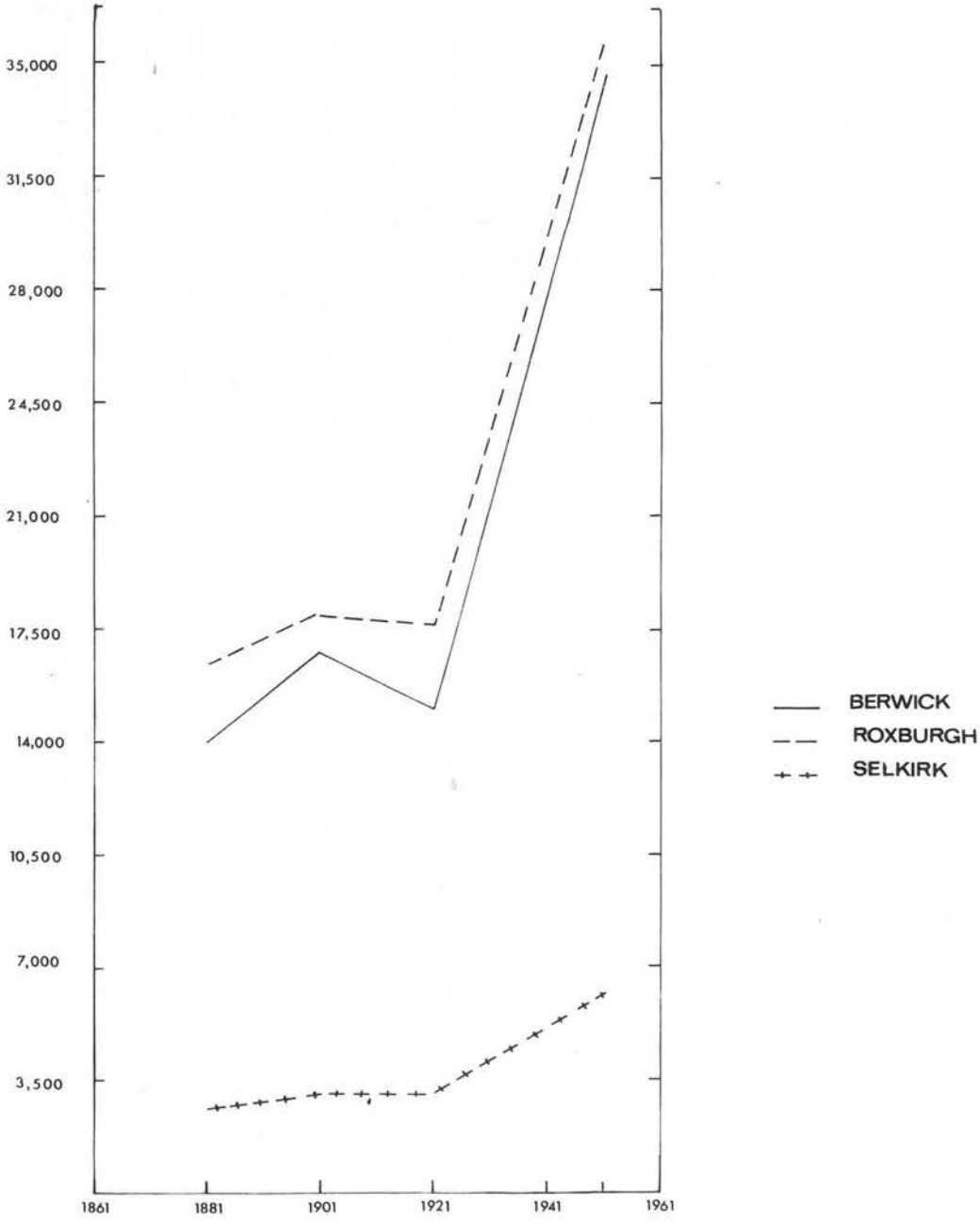

sheep totals.

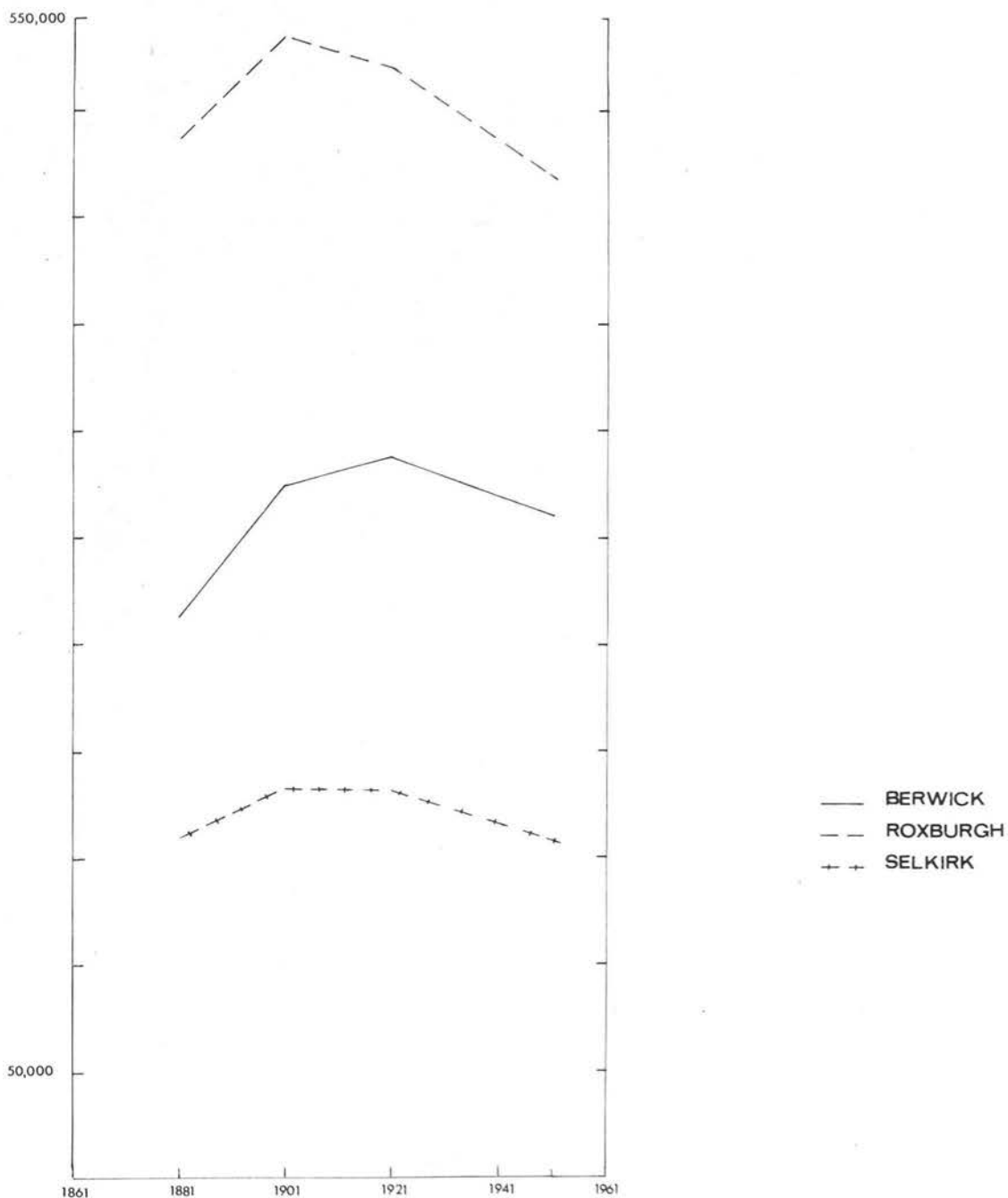

 employment in the extractive industries.

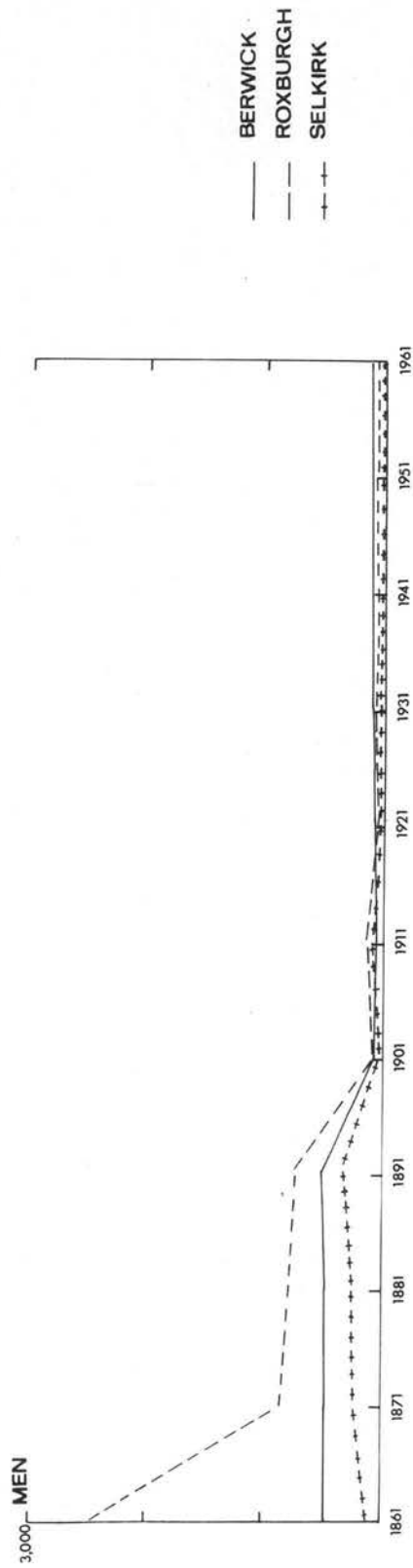

employment in the manufacturing industries (excluding textiles & clothing).

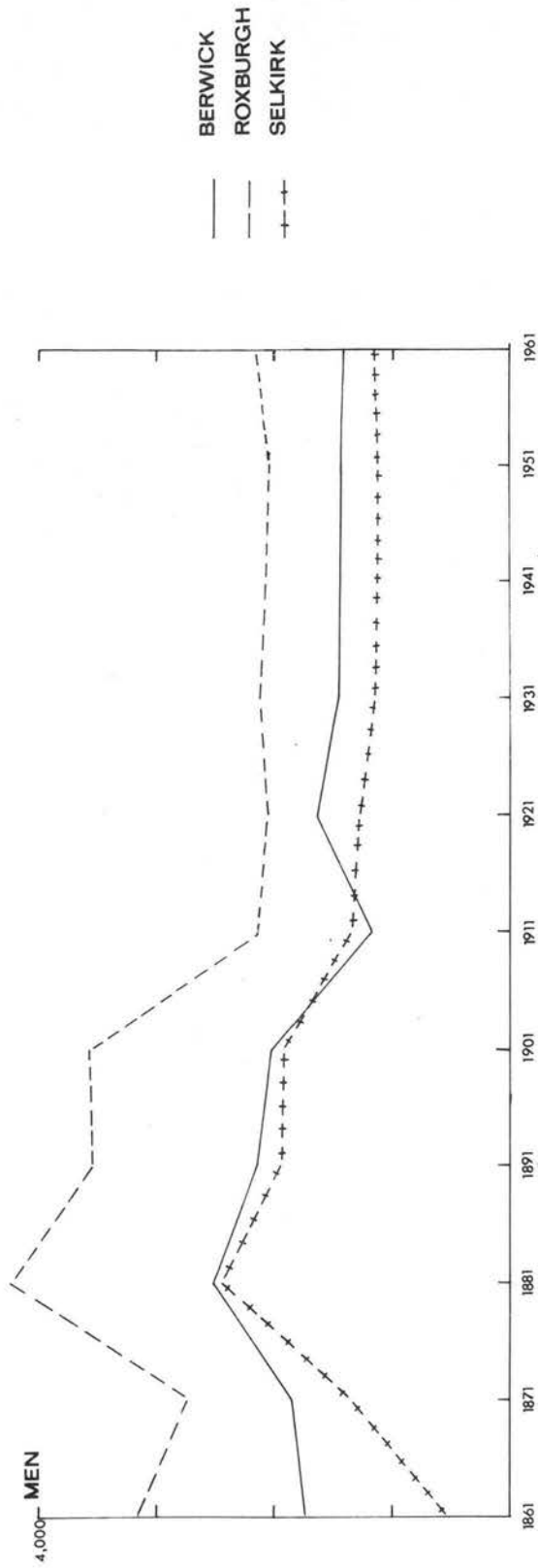

employment in the clothing industry.**

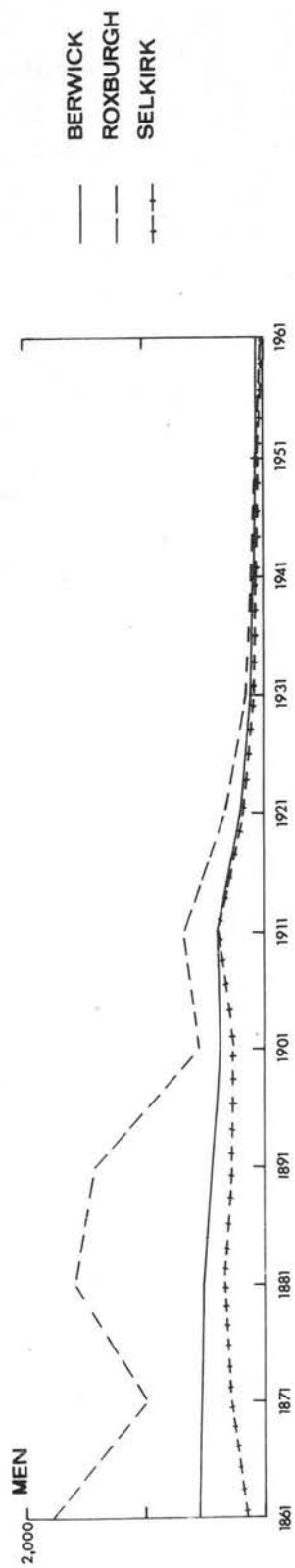

 employment in the clothing industry.

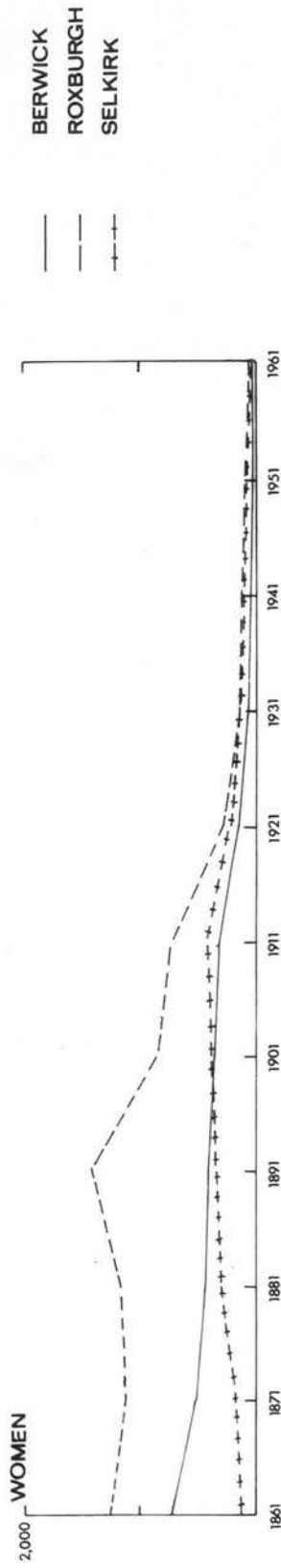

 employment in the textile industry.

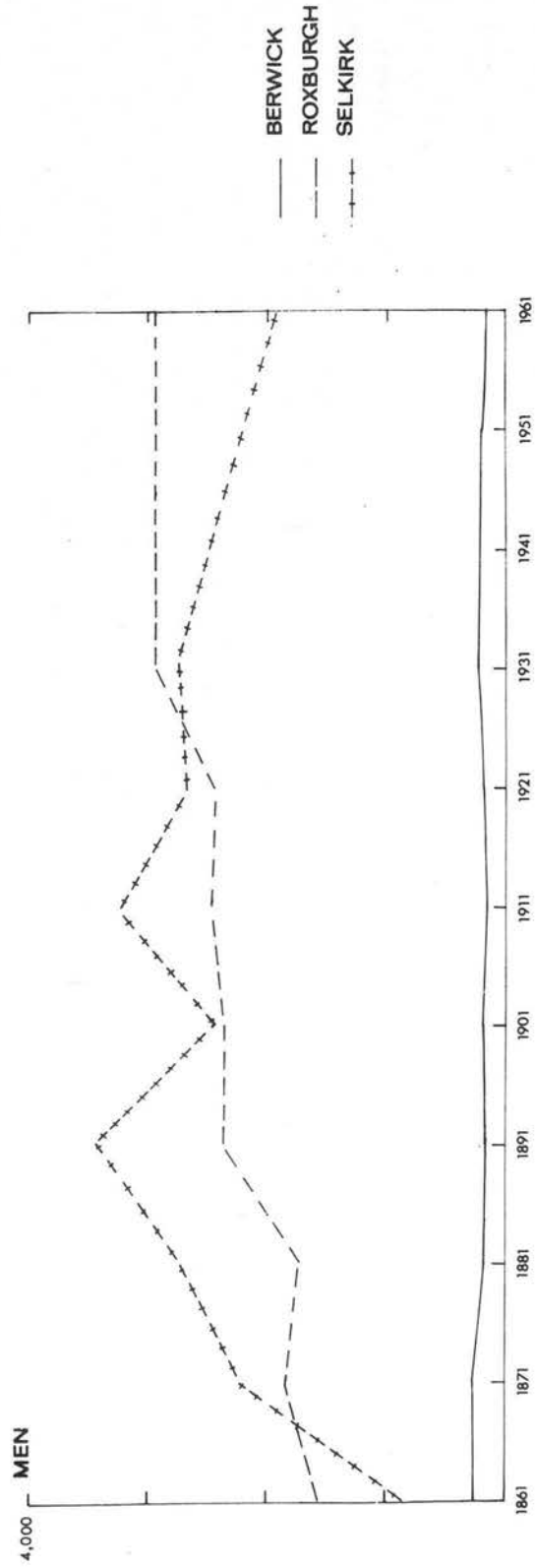

 employment in the textile industry.

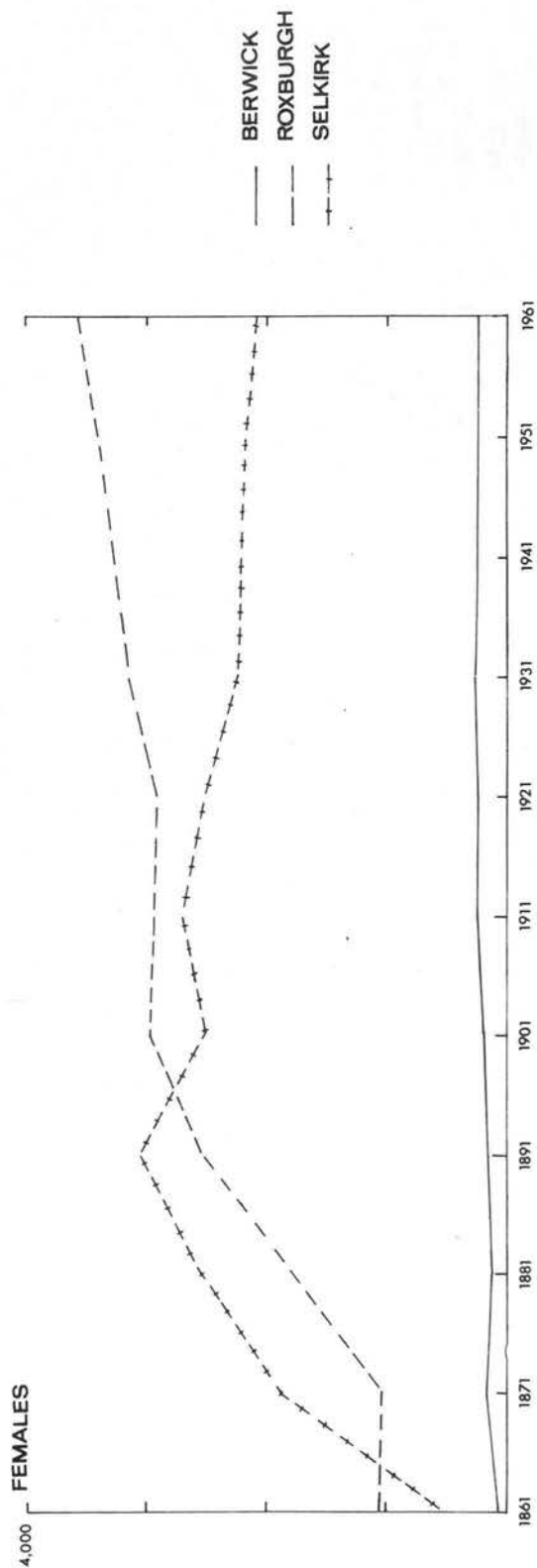

BERWICKSHIRE, employment in tertiary activities.

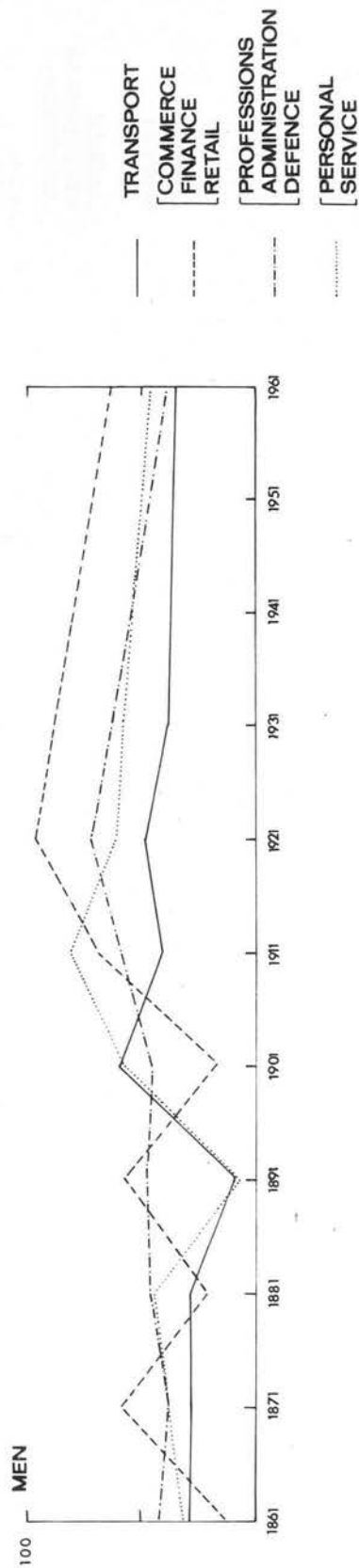

employment in tertiary activities.

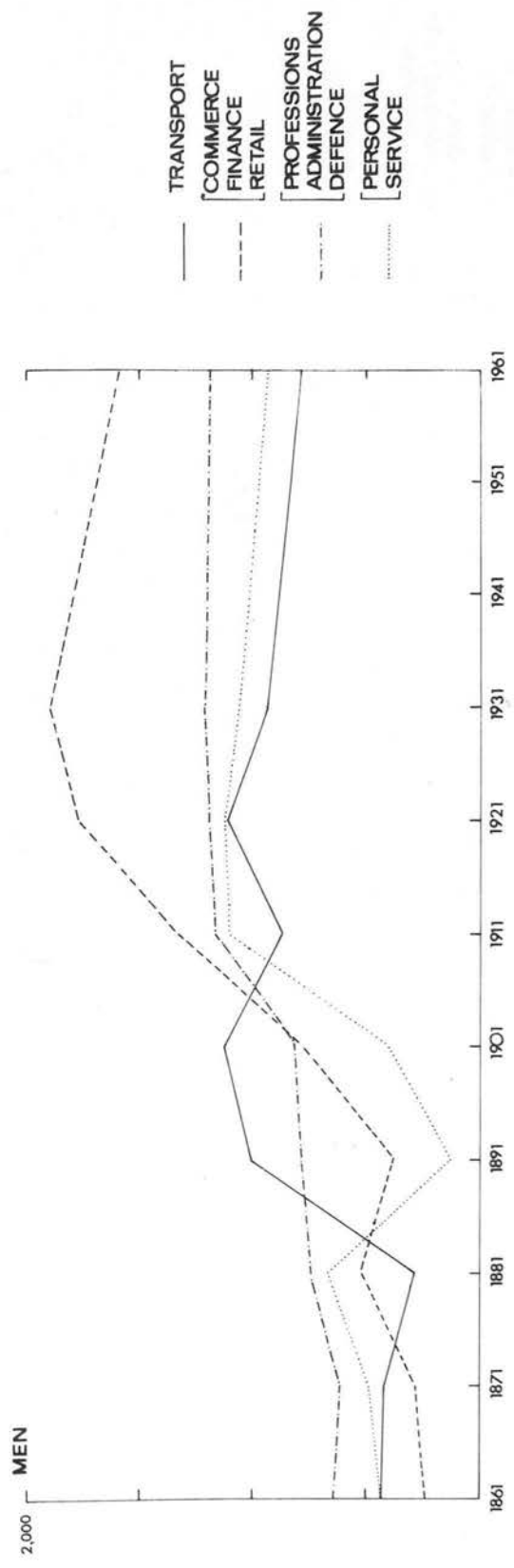

employment in tertiary activities.

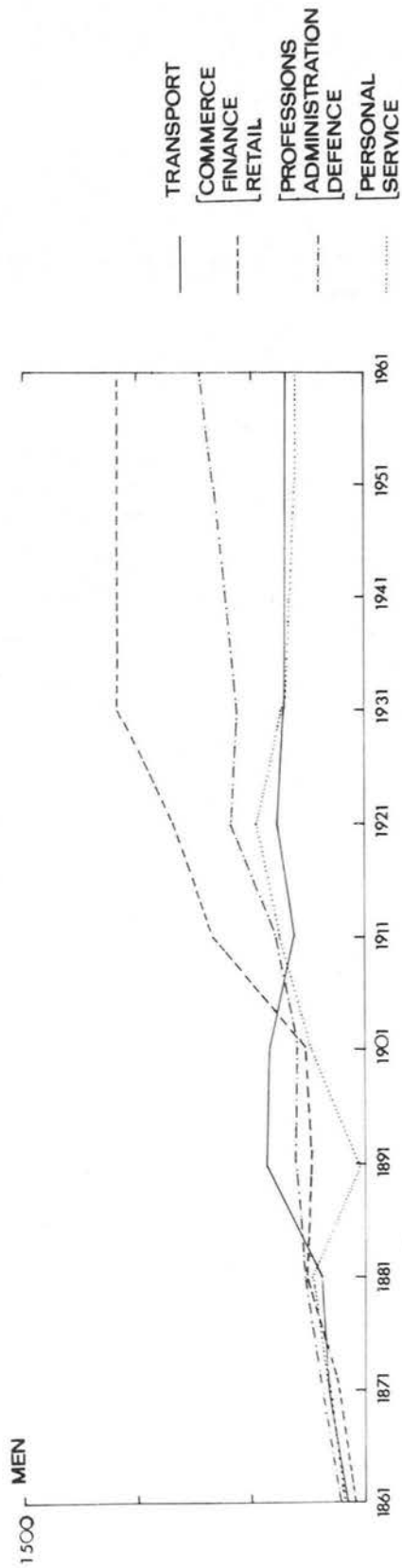
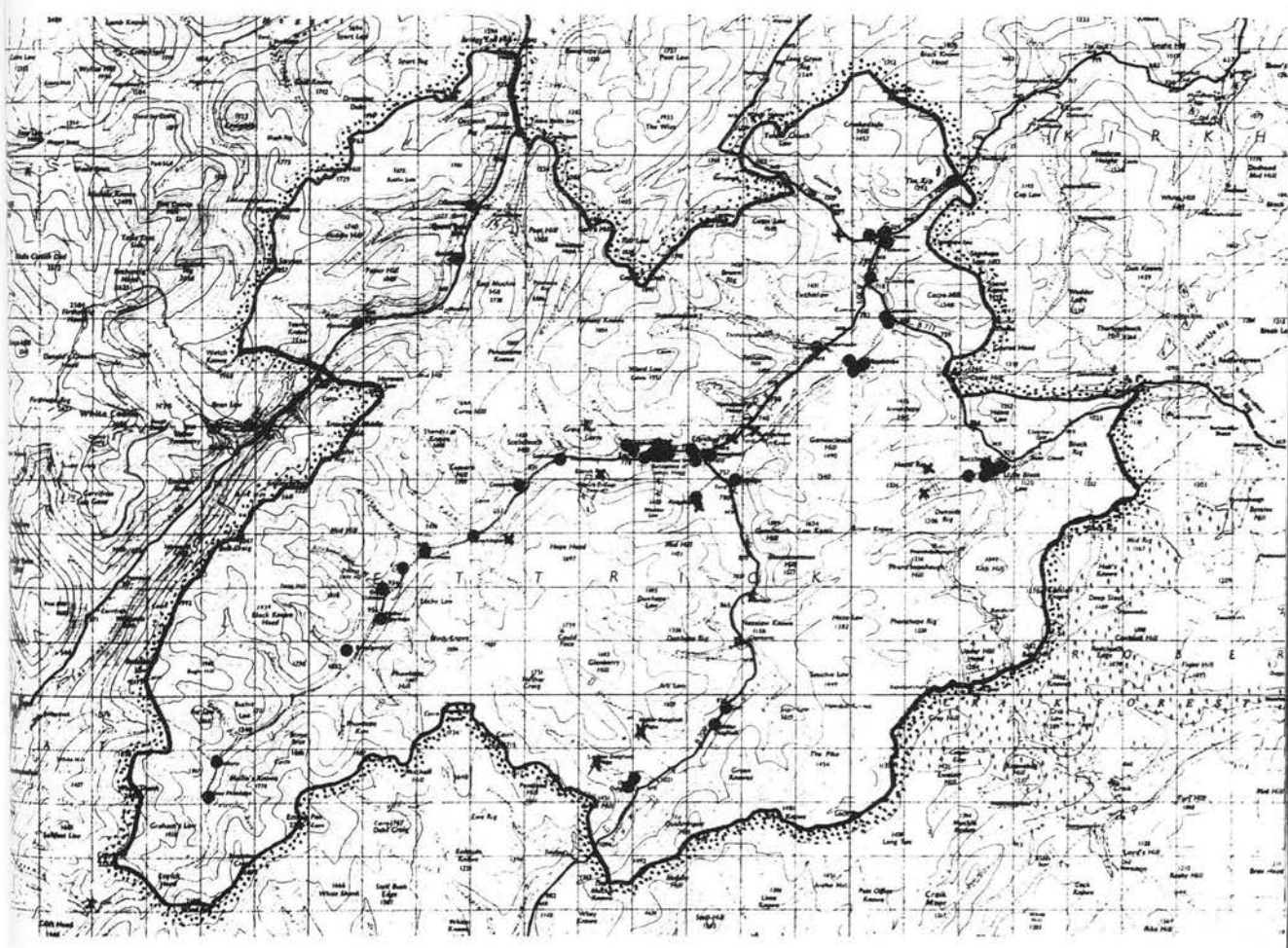

households surveyed.



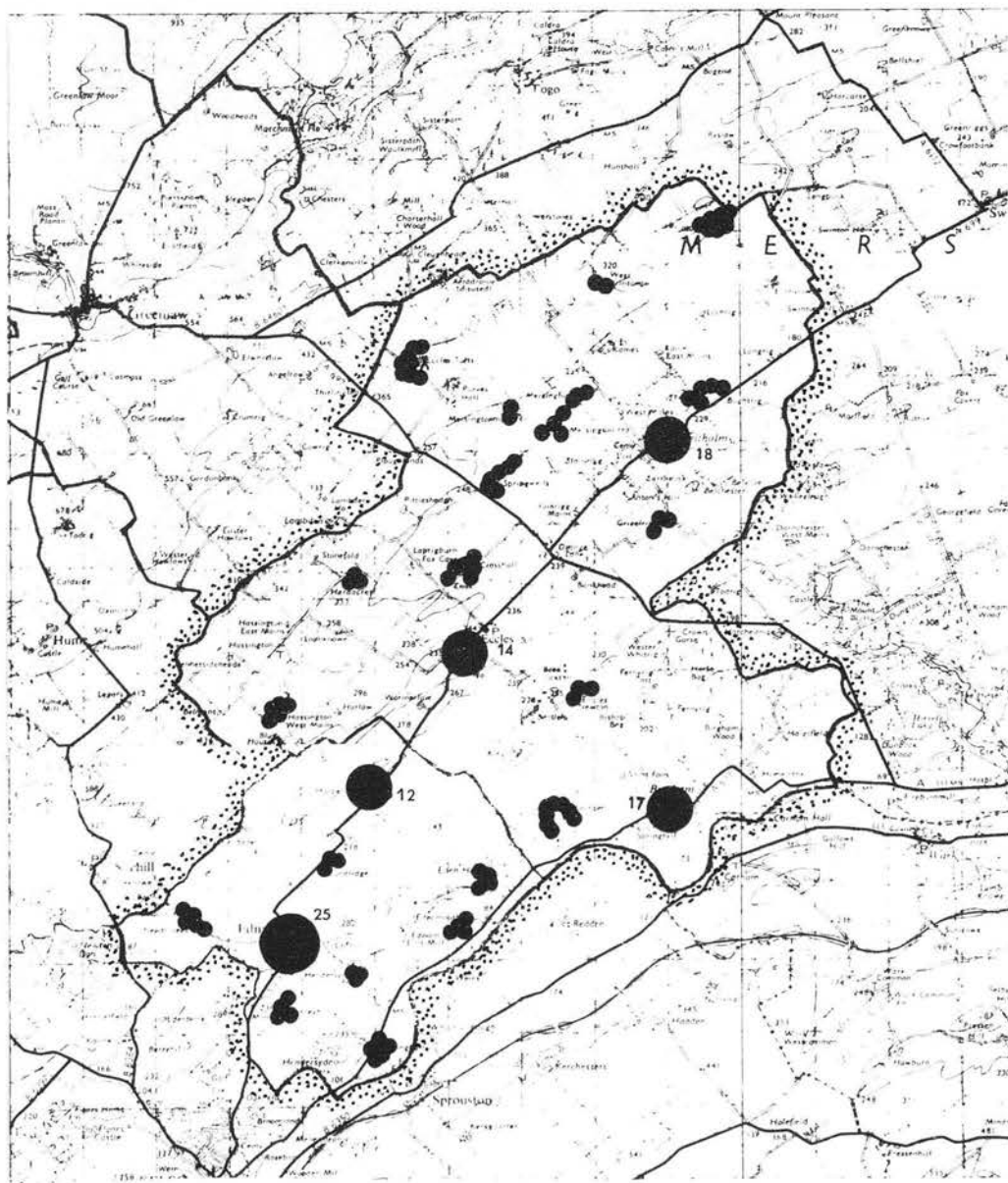

households surveyed.



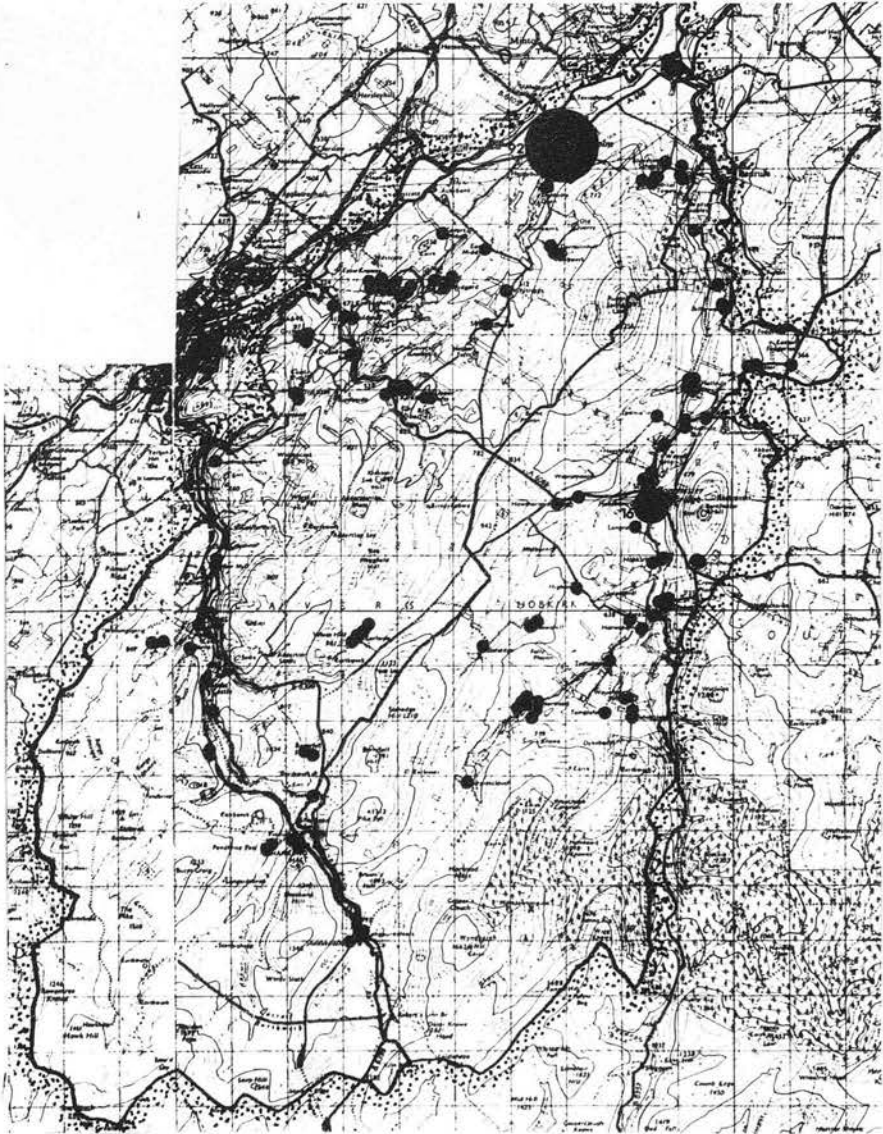

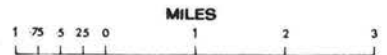

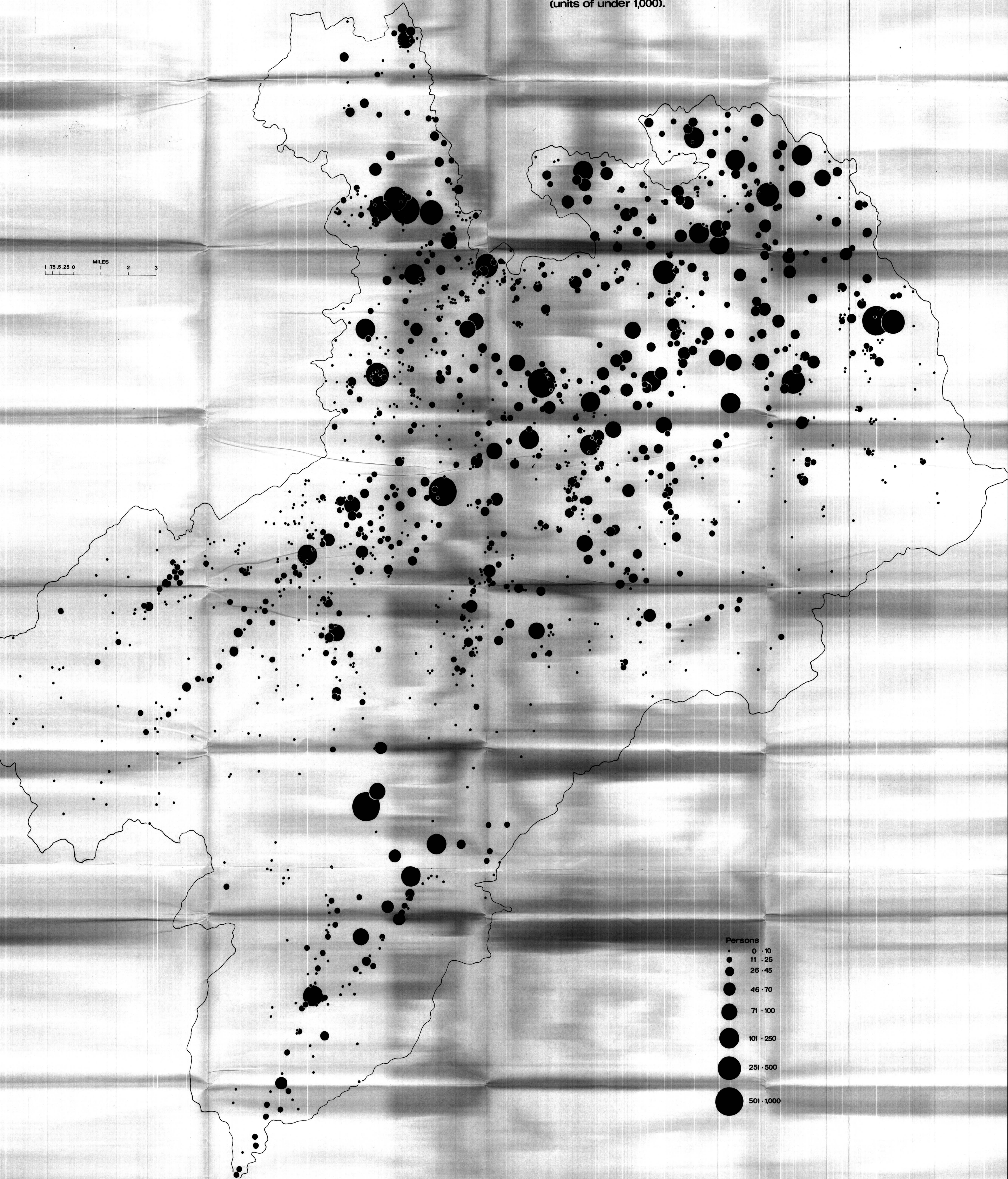
