Changing the mix of animals they keep, choosing risk-tolerant species such as goats or camels



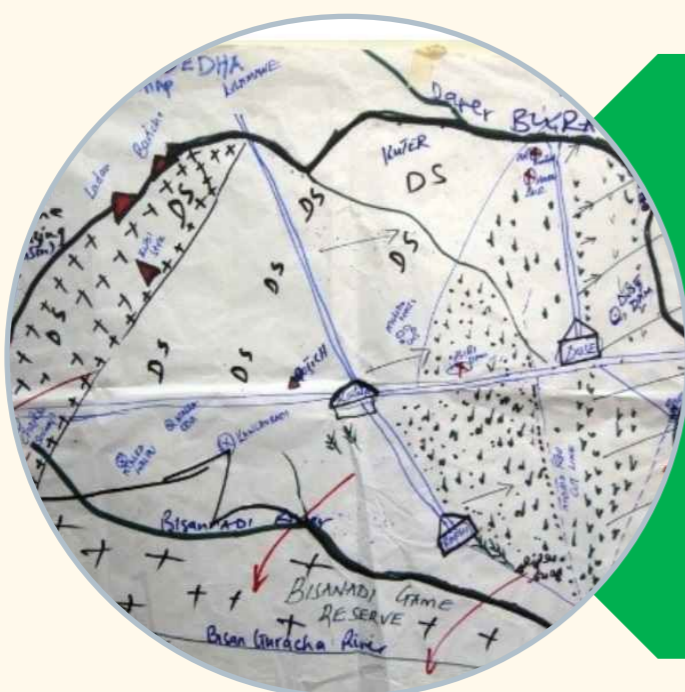
LIVELIHOOD OPTIONS
