HMGA1 gene silencing by RNA interference suppresses the metastatic potential of pancreatic adenocarcinoma cells *in vivo*. At 4 weeks following orthotopic implantation of 1×10^6 MiaPaCa2 cells stably expressing control or shHMGA1 constructs, necropsy was performed. Liver metastases were counted and confirmed histologically. HMGA1 silencing significantly inhibited metastasis in this nude mouse model. Black arrows indicate the site of liver metastasis.
